

Diagnostic Medical Sonography Program Changes to the 2024 Admission Cycle

The following changes are being made to the application requirements for the Diagnostic Medical Sonography program beginning with the 2024 application cycle:

- Completion of **MTH 161** or higher with a "B" or better grade (change from MTH 154 requirement)
- Completion of **DMS 100** Orientation to the Sonography Profession-1 credit (*replaces* the DMS Prospective Student Workshop requirement; this is a 7-week course offered every semester beginning Fall 2023; SIS registration will be available in late summer)

• TEAS Test: Minimum required score of **70** on Reading, Writing, Math, and Science sections (change from minimum score of 50 per section)

All additional application requirements remain the same:

- Review online Information Session
- Have minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA
- Complete or transfer **SDV 101 Orientation to Healthcare** with B or better grade
- Complete or transfer ENG 111 with B or better grade
- Complete or transfer **BIO 141** with B or better grade and be within 5 years
- Complete or transfer **BIO 142** with B or better grade and be within 5 years
- Complete or transfer **PHY 100** with B or better grade and be within 5 years
