

NOVA Radiography Program RT State Licensure Instructions for Graduates

NOVA Radiography graduates may apply for state licensure after passing the ARRT registry exam.

Virginia

1. Apply online and pay the application fee to the Virginia Board of Medicine:

2. Refer to the Board's Online application Instructions and Forms for Radiologic Technologist.

Recent graduates of the program that have never worked as a RT only need to complete **Items 1 to 3** on the checklist. If you have been working as a RT or hold licensure in another state, you must complete all items on the checklist.

3. Checklist Item 2 – **Professional Education**

Graduates must request an official transcript from the NOVA College Records Office and have it sent to the Virginia Board of Medicine. Official transcripts must be sent directly by the college. They may be emailed to radtech-medbd@dhp.virginia.gov. Refer to the NOVA CRO website for instructions on how to request official transcripts. <https://www.nvcc.edu/transcripts/index.html#panel7>

Note: As of November 2022, the Virginia Board of Medicine has updated their requirement for proof of professional education and no longer accepts Form L – Certificate of Professional Education sent by RAD.

Maryland

1. Complete Part 1 of the **RT(R)1 Verification of Education** form.
2. Mail the form to Medical Education Campus, Radiography Department Room 239, 6699 Springfield Center Drive, Springfield VA 22150, Attn: Maryland RAD Licensure.
3. You may also drop the form off in person to Room 239 at the Medical Education Campus in Springfield.

Other States

Graduates will need to check with that state's health board for licensing requirements and procedures.
