

Radiography Program Changes to the 2024 Admission Cycle

The following changes are being made to the application requirements for the Radiography program beginning with the 2024 application cycle:

- <u>Self-place</u> for **MTH 161** (qualify only; completion of MTH 161 is not required)
 Direct Enrollment and Self-Placement Info: <u>www.nvcc.edu/academics/placement/</u>
 (change from qualification for MTH 154)
- **TEAS Test**: Minimum required score of **50** on Reading, Writing, and Math sections (*TEAS Test is being added as a requirement to apply; Science section not required*)

All additional application requirements remain the same:

- Review online Information Session
- Have minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA
- Complete or transfer SDV 101 Orientation to Healthcare or SDV 100; must have B or better grade
- Complete or transfer **ENG 111**, ENG 112, or a 200-level ENG literature course; must have B or better grade
- Complete or transfer **BIO 141**; must have B or better grade and be within 10 years
- Complete or transfer BIO 142; must have B or better grade and be within 10 years
- Complete RAD 105; must have B or better grade

2024 applicants will be reviewed and ranked by:

- Final grades in RAD 105, BIO 141 and BIO 142
- TEAS scores

Additional points awarded for:

- Students that have completed HLT 141 Medical Terminology, a Social Science elective, and a Humanities/Fine Arts elective at time of application
- Students that achieved an "A" on the first attempt in BIO 141 & BIO 142
