- Completed or transferred **SDV 101 Orientation to Healthcare** with B or better grade
  - or SDV 100 College Success Skills with B or better grade
  - or SDV ABLE exam with a score of 38 or higher | [www.nvcc.edu/testing](http://www.nvcc.edu/testing)
  - or previous associate, baccalaureate, or higher degree from an accredited United States institution of higher education | [www.nvcc.edu/cro/transfercredit](http://www.nvcc.edu/cro/transfercredit)
- Qualified for **MTH 161 Precalculus I** by direct enrollment or self-placement (*qualification only*)  
[www.nvcc.edu/academics/placement](http://www.nvcc.edu/academics/placement) | Advising Surveys for Direct Enrollment and Informed Self-Placement must be within the previous 5 years if MTH 161 was never completed
  - or qualify for MTH 161/MDE 61 or a higher math course
- Completed or transferred **ENG 111 College Composition I** with B or better grade
  - or ENG 112 or a 200-level English literature course with B or better grade
- Completed **RAD 105 Intro to Radiology** with B or better grade (*offered at MEC in fall/spring*)
- Completed or transferred **BIO 141 Human Anatomy & Physiology I** with B or better grade within 10 years | [www.nvcc.edu/academics/divisions/health-sciences](http://www.nvcc.edu/academics/divisions/health-sciences)
- Completed or transferred **BIO 142 Human Anatomy & Physiology II** with B or better grade within 10 years
- TEAS Test** with minimum score of 50 in English, Reading, and Math (*science not required*)
  - Highest scores of all attempts within previous 3 years accepted

**How Eligible Applications Will Be Ranked**

- Points for final grades in BIO 141, BIO 142, and RAD 105 (*higher grades = higher points*)
- Points for TEAS scores in English, Reading, and Math (*higher scores = higher points*)
- Additional points for applicants with HLT 141 (*or HLT 143, HIM 111, or med term ABLE exam*), a humanities/fine arts, and a social science completed with a final grade at time of application (*not required to apply*)
- Additional points for applicants that earned an A in the first attempt in BIO 141 and BIO 142
- Radiography accepts top 40 applicants

**Meeting the minimum application requirements does not guarantee acceptance**

Applications with B minus, C, or P+ grades in the prerequisites, and applications with pending grades or transfer credit after the deadline will not be accepted.
