

**NVCC COLLEGE-WIDE COURSE CONTENT SUMMARY
ASL 102 - AMERICAN SIGN LANGUAGE II (4 CR.)**

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Teaches and provides practice with intermediate level vocabulary, idioms, and structures of American Sign Language. Develops low intermediate level communication and conversation skills using ASL.

Lecture 3 hours per week.

GENERAL COURSE PURPOSE

To develop linguistic competency in freely expressing oneself in ASL and understanding ASL at a low intermediate level.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

By the end of the semester the student will be able to:

- A. Accurately produce sign vocabulary and grammatical structures that are introduced and practiced in both controlled and free expressive situations at 85% or better,
- B. Comprehend sign vocabulary and grammatical features introduced and practiced in class at 85% or better,
- C. Comprehend and produce ASL introduced in the class at a normal rate of communication.
