



CAAHEP Accredited Paramedic Programs and CoAEMSP Letter of Review (LoR) Programs track and report outcome measures annually to the Committee on Accreditation for the Emergency Medical Services Professions (CoAEMSP). The most current CoAEMSP Annual Report was for the calendar year 2019.

The 2019 outcomes, for Northern Va. Community College, are noted below, all of which surpass the minimal outcome thresholds that are required by CoAEMSP.

The most recent success rate for the National Registry of EMT Paramedic Cognitive exam was **83.3%**.

Positive placement is defined by the CoAEMSP as ‘Employed full or part-time in a related field and/or continuing his/her education and/or serving in the military’. Positive placement is measured at completion of the program.

The most recent positive placement rate for graduates was **80%**.

The program’s graduate retention rate, for this time frame, was **80.6%**, with an overall attrition rate of 19.4% respectably.
