Meeting the minimum application criteria does not guarantee acceptance

Nursing Application Requirements	Completed
Admitted to NOVA	
18 years of age or older	
High school diploma or General Educational Development Test certification (GED) <i>(international high school transcripts must first be evaluated by an international evaluation agency – please see Transcript Evaluation Process)</i>	
View online Nursing information session	
Take English and Math placement tests (if applicable) and qualify for MTH 154	
One unit of high school or college-level algebra and two units of science (1 unit of biology and 1 unit of chemistry) with a grade of “C” or higher	
Complete SDV 101 Orientation to Healthcare (or equivalent) with a “C” or higher and grade posted	
Complete ENG 111 with a “C” or higher and grade posted	
Complete PSY 230 with a “C” or higher and grade posted	
Complete BIO 141 with a “C” or higher and grade posted	
Complete 3 credit General Elective and grade posted	
Minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA from last school attended	
Complete all 4 sections of the ATI-TEAS test: Reading, Math, Science and English with required minimum scores. Reading minimum score: 73% Math minimum score: 65% Science minimum score: 52% English minimum score: 62%	
Students transferring from another nursing program must submit a letter from the Dean/Director of the previous program attesting that the applicant left the previous nursing program in good academic standing
