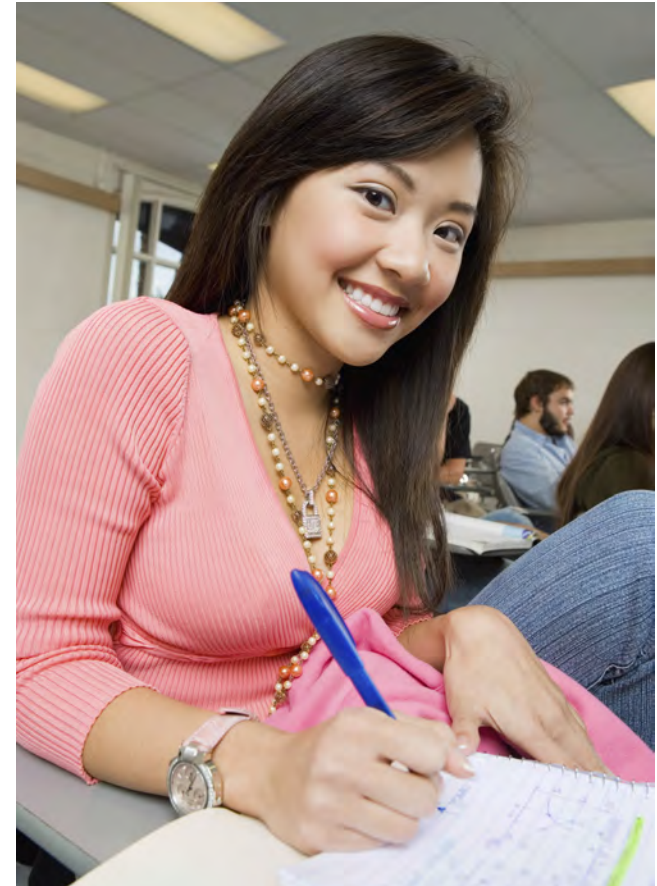

## WELCOME!

We offer degrees in General Studies, Business Administration and Liberal Arts. The Specialized Degree Programs allows working adults the flexibility to attend classes on Fridays only or Evenings only. Many of our classes are offered in a blended hybrid format 50% in person and 50% online.

Every student in our program has the opportunity to work with a counselor who will advise you academically based on your individual needs. NOVA offers many academic and financial aid support services, which we and your fellow students will assist you in learning to navigate.



## FRIDAYS ONLY COHORT

Through completion of the Fridays Only Cohort Program students can earn a General Studies A.S. Degree in two years by attending classes only on Fridays. This program includes a combination of in-person, hybrid, and online courses, and is designed for students who have work or family obligations and need flexibility when pursuing their degree.

## GOVERNMENT CENTER CLASSES

Starting in the spring semester, NOVA will offer a certificate in Business Leadership. All classes will be held one night a week at the Fairfax Government Center or online. The program is designed for employees who are currently, or hope to be, in leadership, human resources, or supervisory managerial positions in the Fairfax County Government. The certificate is especially appropriate for individuals who have a degree related to their field training in team leadership or managerial skills.
