## Outcomes of First-Time, Full-Time Degree or Certificate-Seeking Students at NOVA: Fall 2008 through Fall 2014 Cohorts

This Brief presents outcomes of first-time, full-time degree or certificate-seeking students at NOVA for the Fall 2008 through Fall 2014 cohorts. (Table 1 and Figures 1-3, next page)

## **Key Findings**

- The three-year <u>graduation rate</u> for first-time, full-time degree or certificate-seeking students in the Fall 2014 cohort was 25 percent, which was seven percentage points higher than the Fall 2008 cohort (18 percent).
- The three-year <u>transfer-out rate</u> for first-time, full-time degree or certificate-seeking students in the Fall 2014 cohort was 16 percent, which was five percentage points higher than the Fall 2008 cohort (11 percent).
- The three-year <u>still enrolled at NOVA rate</u> for first-time, full-time degree or certificate-seeking students in the Fall 2014 cohort was 19 percent, which was three percentage points lower than the Fall 2008 cohort (22 percent).




Figure 2. Three-Year <u>Transfer-Out Rate</u> of First-Time, Full-Time Degree or Certificate-Seeking Students at NOVA: Fall 2008 through Fall 2014 Cohorts




Figure 3. Three-Year <u>Still Enrolled at NOVA Rate</u> of First-Time, Full-Time Degree or Certificate-Seeking Students at NOVA: Fall 2008 through Fall 2014 Cohorts
