First-Time in College Students who Enrolled at NOVA Within One Year of Graduation from High School: Fall 2018

Introduction

Northern Virginia Community College (NOVA) regularly monitors and evaluates eight critical measures of student achievement. One of these measures, enrollment, refers to the headcount of students enrolled in credit courses; students enrolled in courses that are part of a vocational or educational program, including those enrolled in off-campus centers; and high school students taking college courses for credit.

NOVA sets enrollment targets each year with respect to the overarching goals set forth in the College's most recent strategic plan: every student succeeds, every program achieves, and every community prospers. To this end, NOVA tracks several areas related to enrollment including enrollment of first-time college students from NOVA's service region, continued enrollment of existing students, enrollment of dual-enrolled high school students, and the enrollment of students who transfer into NOVA from another two- or four-year institution.

In This Brief

This Brief examines the **draw rate** of students from public high school divisions in NOVA's service area in Fall 2018. The draw rate is the rate at which recent graduates from public high schools in the Northern Virginia area attended NOVA in the fall term following graduation from high school. Additionally, this brief shows the number of students who enroll from each public school division as well as the most popular program in which recent high school graduates enroll. This information will assist College leadership with a better understanding of Northern Virginia school divisions with the greatest potential for new enrollments at NOVA.

Key Findings

- The highest draw rate of recent high school graduates was from Prince William County Public Schools, in which 25 percent of graduates enrolled at NOVA.
- The highest number of recent graduates who enrolled at NOVA was from Fairfax County Public Schools, in which over 2,000 students from this division enrolled at NOVA.
- The most popular degree program for recent high school graduates was General Studies, A.S.


Enrollment At NOVA After High School from NOVA's Service Region

- In Fall 2018, the public school division in NOVA's service area with the highest <u>draw rate</u> was Prince William County Public Schools (PWCPS). Approximately 25 percent of high school graduates from PWCPS enrolled at NOVA following high school. (Figure 1)
- In Fall 2018, the public school division with the highest <u>number</u> of students enrolling at NOVA was Fairfax County Public Schools (FCPS). Over 2,000 FCPS graduates enrolled at NOVA in the year following high school graduation. (Figure 2)

Figure 1. Draw Rate from NOVA's Service Area by Public School Division: Fall 2018







Most Popular Programs for Recent High School Graduates

- In Fall 2018, recent high school graduates who enrolled at NOVA most commonly enrolled in a General Studies A.S. degree program. Approximately 27 percent of all recent high school graduates enrolled at NOVA were enrolled in this program.
- Other popular programs for recent high school graduates include A.S. degree programs in Business Administration (13 percent), Science, and Social Science (10 percent, each).
