This report provides enrollment data at Northern Virginia Community College (NOVA). The report presents these data by pathway and program. The data presented include the following for four terms:

- Annual program-placed FTES by academic pathway, academic program, and campus
- Unduplicated number of program-placed students by academic pathway, academic program, and campus¹
- Number of graduates per year by academic program and campus
- Graduation rate by academic program
- Graduation rate by race/ethnicity

A note about how the graduation rate was calculated is provided below. It is also included in the notes for the relevant data tables.

Graduation Rate Calculation

Graduation rate is the percentage of first time, full-time, program-placed students who completed their program within 150 percent of normal time to program completion.

In this report, the graduation rate is calculated according to the following formula:

$$\text{Graduation Rate} = (\# \text{ of Graduates} / \# \text{ of Students in Cohort}) * 100$$

¹ The number of program-placed students—including secondary, tertiary, etc. and program placement (i.e., duplicated program placement)—was unavailable at the time of publication.
