**FTES Enrollment by Discipline – Alexandria Campus:  
Fall 2015 through Fall 2019**

This research brief provides full-time equivalent student (FTES) enrollment data by discipline at Northern Virginia Community College's (NOVA) Alexandria Campus for the Fall 2015 through Fall 2019 semesters. Semester FTES, a unit equal to 15 credits, is calculated by dividing the total number of semester credits by 15. The FTES data in Table 1 are sorted in descending order (i.e., largest to smallest) by Fall 2019 FTES. A list of discipline prefixes and descriptions is provided at the end of this research brief (Table 2).

- The disciplines that decreased over this period are highlighted in **blue** (50.0 percent or more) and **yellow** (20.0 to 49.0 percent).
- The disciplines that increased over this period are highlighted in **purple** (20.0 to 49.0 percent) and **green** (50.0 percent or more).

**Key Findings**

- At the Alexandria Campus, fall semester FTES enrollment **decreased** by 14 percent (716 FTES) between Fall 2015 and Fall 2019. In comparison, fall semester FTES enrollment **decreased** by 8 percent (2,452 FTES) College-wide during the period.
- Between Fall 2015 and Fall 2019 at the Alexandria Campus,
  - Fall semester FTES enrollment **decreased by 50 percent or more** in the MTT, PED, AUB, FIN, NAS, BSK, HUM, ITA, REA, GER, CON, AST, and POR disciplines.
  - Fall semester FTES enrollment **decreased by 20 to 49 percent** in the ESL, BIO, CST, HIS, PSY, CHM, ACC, SPA, FRE, ARA, JPN, HLT, and RUS disciplines.
  - Fall semester FTES enrollment **increased by 20 to 49 percent** in the MTH, AUT, ADJ, GOL, and CIV disciplines.
  - Fall semester FTES enrollment **increased by 50 percent or more** in the BUS, BLD, ENV, LAT, and EDU disciplines.
