Introduction

Northern Virginia Community College (NOVA) uses several measures to evaluate student achievement in support of its mission and strategic plan, which states a commitment to the values of access, opportunity, student success, and excellence. In particular, the College aims to provide students with access to high-quality, postsecondary education in the Northern Virginia region, as well as promote success by preparing students to graduate, transfer out, and enter the workforce with improved educational and labor market skills.

NOVA demonstrates its commitment to the values of student access and student success through well-established processes that evaluate and improve student achievement. In particular, NOVA measures eight student achievement criteria as reported to the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC): 1) College Readiness; 2) Enrollment; 3) Course Success; 4) Retention; 5) Graduation; **6) Transfer**; 7) Job Placement; and 8) Licensing Exams.

The analysis presented in this Report provides data regarding the transfer patterns of students who either graduated from NOVA before transferring or who transferred out of NOVA without first earning a degree. This information is intended to further optimize programs like ADVANCE—a collaboration between NOVA and its most popular transfer institution, George Mason University. Information about students' transfer patterns, including whether they transferred with or without a credential and to which institutions, can aid NOVA's faculty and staff in planning pathway improvements. Both the ADVANCE partnership and NOVA's guided pathways show early signs of success. This Report provides critical updates to an earlier report series examining students who transferred out of NOVA. The present Report shows trends in transfer rates over time (Section A) and the most popular transfer institutions for NOVA students (Section B).

All students can benefit from having clear pathways when transferring from a community college to a four-year institution. While not all students earn a credential prior to transferring, research suggests that students who earn an associate degree may be better positioned for transfer as well as their working lives beyond college. This is partly because students who transfer without first earning a degree may be unable to transfer all of the credits that they earned while attending community college.¹

Transfer figures use data from both the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia (SCHEV) and the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC), as provided by Virginia's Community Colleges (VCCS).

Executive Summary

Section A. Transfer Trends

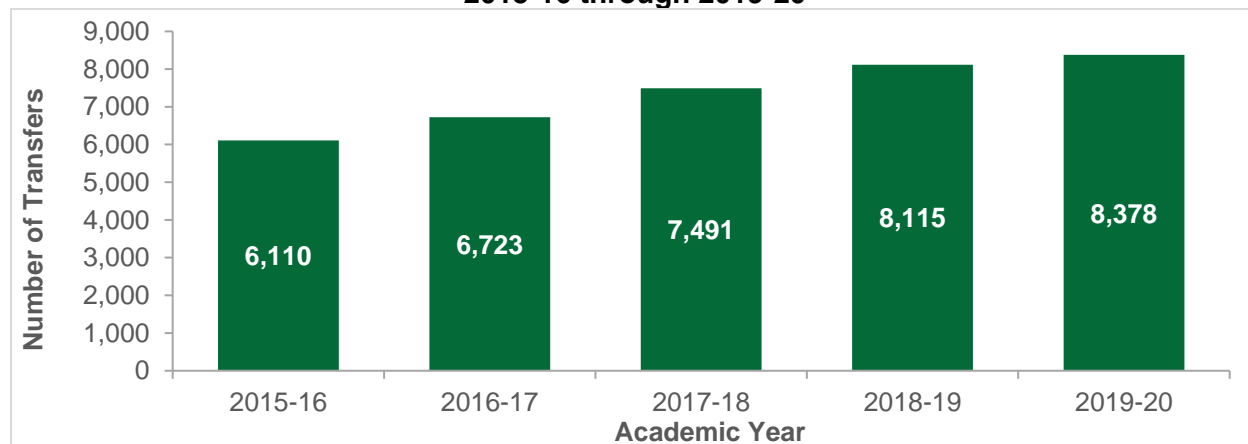
Figure 1. Number of Transfers to Four-Year Institutions: 2015-16 through 2019-20

- Over 12,000 NOVA students transferred to a four-year institution during the 2019-20 academic year, a 33 percent increase over 2015-16 (**Figure 1**).
- Seventy-nine percent of transfers to four-year institutions in 2019-20 (9,632 students) transferred to a public institution rather than a private institution (**Figure 1**).

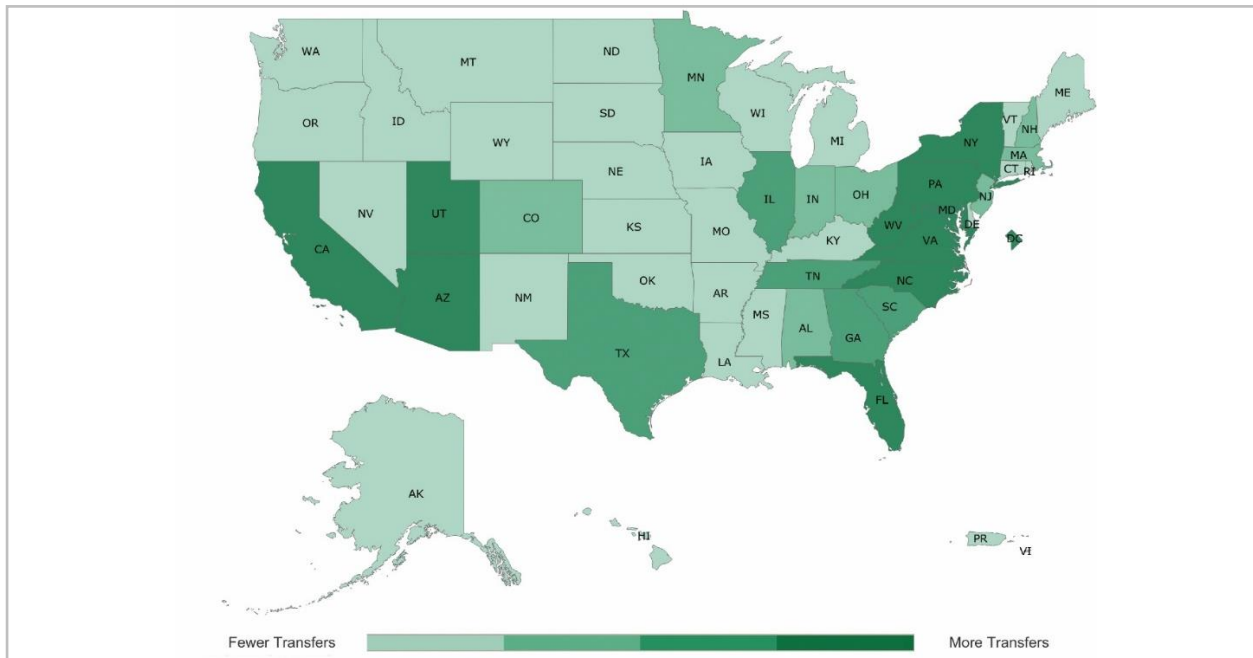
Figure 2. Number of Transfers to Four-Year Institutions in Virginia: 2015-16 through 2019-20

- From 2015-16 to 2019-20, the number of NOVA students who transferred to public institutions increased by 42 percent, and the number of students who transferred to private institutions increased by 8 percent. The number of students who transferred to Virginia schools increased by 37 percent from 2015-16 to 2019-20 (**Figures 1 & 2**).
- In 2019-20, NOVA students transferred to four-year institutions in all 50 states, as well as Washington, D.C., Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands (**Figure 3**).
- Among transfers to four-year institutions in Virginia, the percentage of students who identified as a minority race or ethnicity increased from 58 percent to 62 percent from 2015-16 to 2019-20 (**Figure 4**).
- The number of NOVA students who transferred without a NOVA award increased by 46 percent from 2015-16 to 2019-20, while the number who transferred with a NOVA award increased by 8 percent (**Figure 5 & Table 2**).
- Among students who transferred with a NOVA award during the 2019-20 academic year, 74 percent earned an A.S. degree and 26 percent earned a General Studies, A.S. degree (**Figure 6 and Tables 3 & 4**).
- Most NOVA students who earned an award prior to transferring to a four-year institution were in the General Studies pathway at NOVA (36 percent in 2019-20) (**Table 5**).

Section B. Top Transfer Institutions

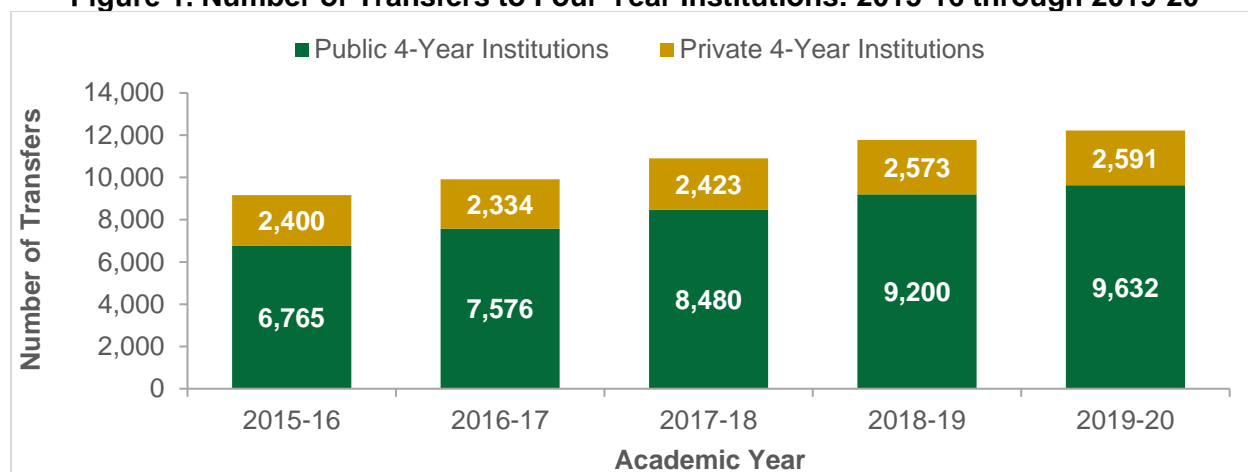

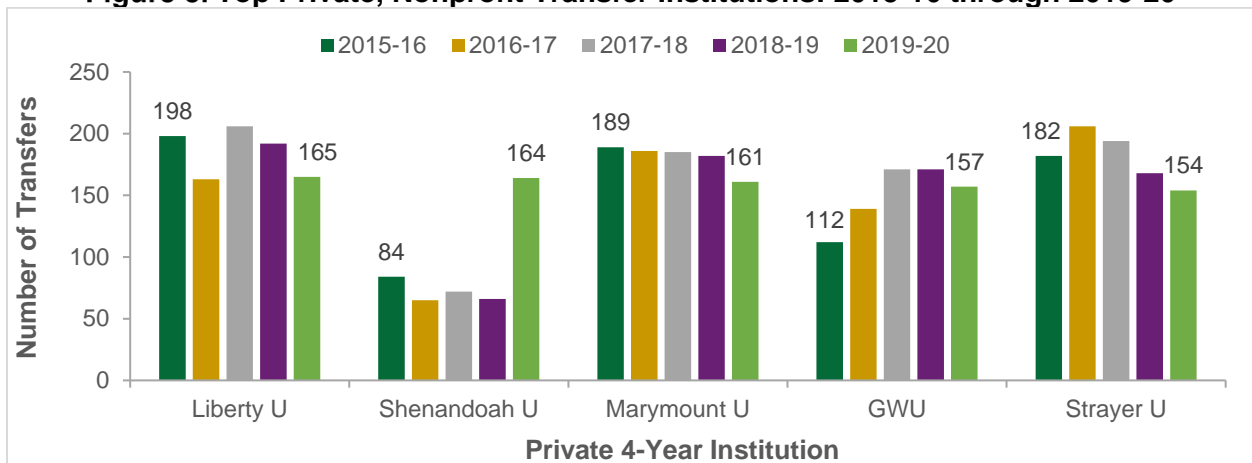
Figure 7. Top Public Transfer Institutions: 2015-16 through 2019-20

- Between 2015-16 and 2019-20, most NOVA transfer students enrolled at George Mason University (GMU) (**Figure 7 and Table 6**).
- In 2019-20, 3,277 NOVA students transferred to GMU. The next most popular transfer institutions were Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University (VA Tech) (1,131 students), Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) (968 students), and James Madison University (JMU) (882 students) (**Figure 7**).
- Sixty percent of students who transferred with a NOVA award enrolled at GMU in 2019-20, compared to 15 percent of transfers without an award (1,982 versus 1,295 students, respectively) (**Table 6**).

Section A. Transfer Trends

The number of NOVA students who transferred to a four-year institution increased over time (see Figure 1).

- During the 2019-20 academic year, 12,223 NOVA students transferred to a four-year institution, a 33 percent increase over 2015-16 (9,165 transfers).
- Seventy-nine percent of transfers to four-year institutions in 2019-20 (9,632 students) transferred to a public institution rather than a private institution.
- The number of NOVA students who transferred to a public institution increased by 42 percent from 2015-16 to 2019-20. Transfers to private institutions increased by eight percent during the same period.

Between 2015-16 and 2019-20, 69 percent of students who transferred out of NOVA enrolled at a four-year institution located in Virginia. The number of students who transferred to Virginia schools increased by 37 percent during this period (see Figure 2).

In 2019-20, NOVA students transferred to four-year institutions in all 50 states, as well as Washington, D.C., Puerto Rico, and the Virgin Islands (see Figure 3).

Most NOVA transfer students in 2019-20 enrolled at four-year institutions in Virginia (8,378 transfers), Washington, D.C. (450), Maryland (355), Pennsylvania (279), West Virginia (233), Florida (215), and New York (201) (see Table 1).

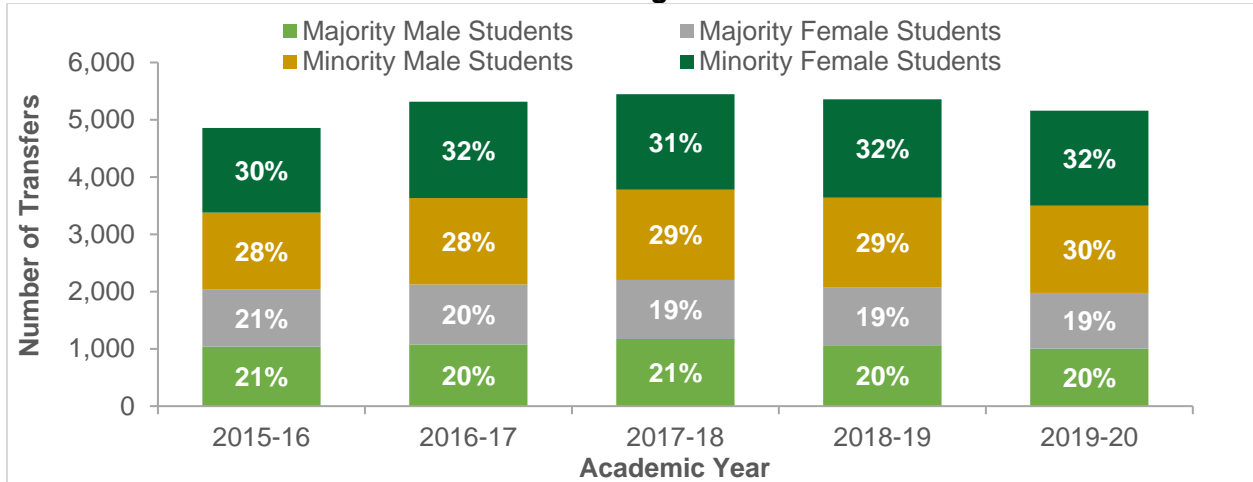

Of transfers to four-year institutions in Virginia, the percentage who identified as a minority race or ethnicity increased from 58 percent to 62 percent from 2015-16 to 2019-20 (see Figure 4).

Figure 4. Transfers to Four-Year Institutions in Virginia by Minority Status and Gender: 2015-16 through 2019-20

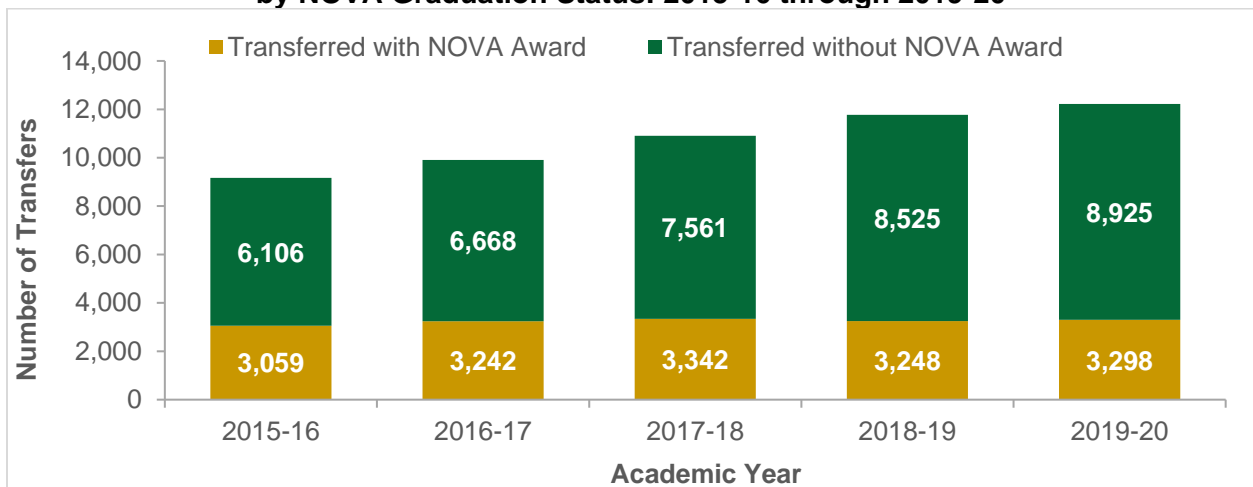

The College's implementation of guided pathways and the ADVANCE partnership with George Mason University (GMU) are expected to increase the number of students who earn a NOVA degree or award prior to transferring to a four-year institution (see Figure 5 and Table 2).

- Since 2015-16, the number of NOVA students who transferred *without* an award increased by 46 percent, while the number who transferred *with* an award increased by 8 percent.
- In 2015-16, 3,059 students earned a NOVA award prior to transferring. In 2019-20, 3,298 students completed a NOVA award prior to transferring, down slightly from 3,342 transfers with award in 2017-18.

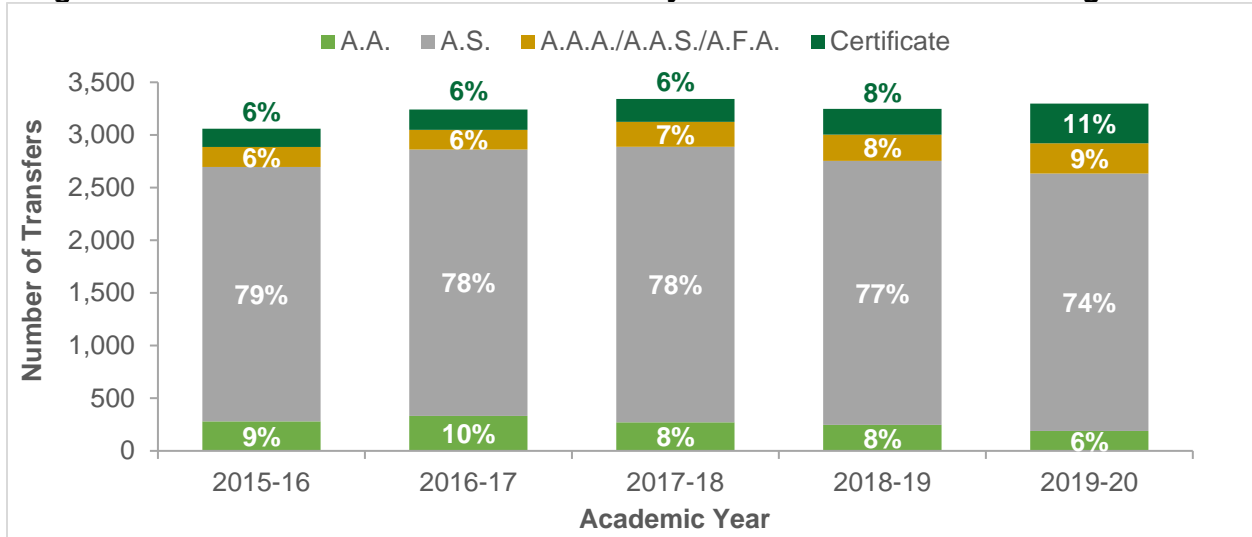

Most NOVA students who earned a degree or certificate prior to transferring to a four-year institution earned an A.S. degree. Between 2015-16 and 2019-20, between 74 and 79 percent of students who completed a NOVA degree or certificate prior to transferring earned an A.S. degree (see Figure 6 and Table 3).

In 2019-20, a plurality of students who earned a degree or certificate prior to transferring to a four-year institution were enrolled in the General Studies pathway at NOVA (36 percent). Seventeen percent of students who transferred with an award were in the Business and Hospitality Management pathway, and ten percent were in the Information and Engineering Technologies pathway (see Table 5).

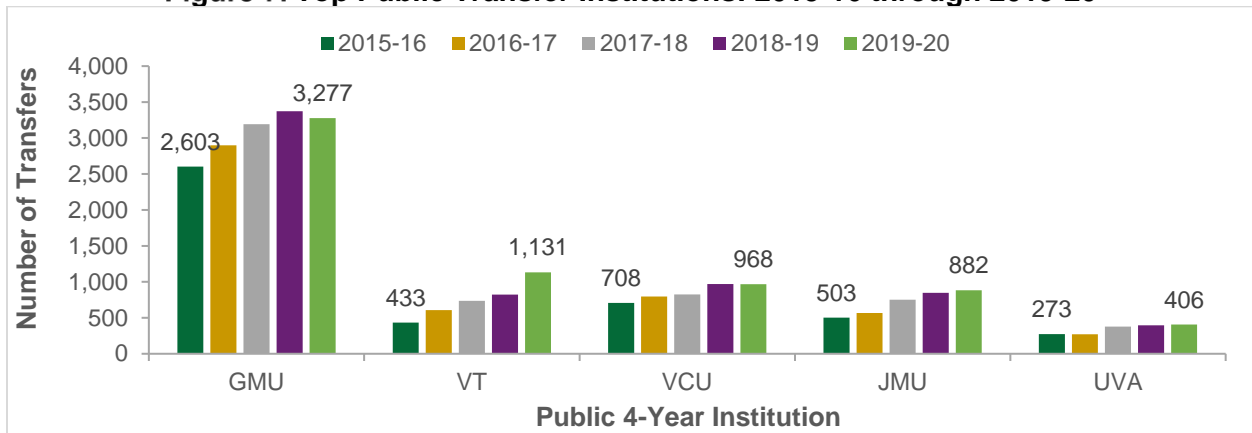

Section B. Top Transfer Institutions

This section presents data on the most popular transfer institutions for NOVA students.²

- Among both public and private nonprofit four-year transfer institutions, most NOVA students transferred to George Mason University (GMU) between 2015-16 and 2019-20 (see Figures 7 and 8).
- In 2019-20, over 3,200 NOVA students transferred to GMU.
- Other top public transfer institutions in 2019-20 included Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University (Virginia Tech), Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU), James Madison University (JMU), and the University of Virginia (UVA) (Figure 7).

Among private, nonprofit four-year transfer institutions, most NOVA students transferred to Liberty University, Shenandoah University, Marymount University, George Washington University (GWU), and Strayer University in Washington, DC.

A higher percentage of students who transferred with a NOVA award enrolled at certain four-year institutions compared to students who transferred prior to earning a degree or certificate from NOVA.

- Sixty percent of students who transferred with a NOVA award enrolled at GMU in 2019-20 (1,982 students); in comparison, only 15 percent of students who transferred without an award enrolled at GMU (1,295 students).
- A larger number of students without a NOVA award transferred to Virginia Tech, JMU, VCU, UVA, and ODU compared to students with a NOVA award.
