# 2018-19 Northern Virginia Public High School Graduates Enrolled at NOVA in 2019-20

This brief presents data on Northern Virginia public high school graduates who graduated in 2018-19 and enrolled at Northern Virginia Community College (NOVA) in 2019-20. The Northern Virginia region is of primary interest in this brief. This region encompasses eight public school divisions: Alexandria City, Arlington County, Fairfax County, Falls Church City, Loudoun County, Manassas City, Manassas Park City, and Prince William County.

### Section 1. 2018-19 Northern Virginia Public High School Graduates Enrolled at NOVA by School Division: 2019-20

Section 1 presents 2018-19 Northern Virginia public high school graduates who enrolled at NOVA during 2019-20 by school division. Data are organized by school division with affiliated high schools presented alphabetically.

- Overall, 22 percent of 2018-19 Northern Virginia high school graduates enrolled at NOVA in 2019-20.
- The four high schools with the greatest percentages of graduates who enrolled at NOVA were Falls Church (Fairfax County school division, 34 percent), Park View (Loudoun County, 32 percent), Forest Park (Prince William County school division, 32 percent), and Annandale (Fairfax County, 31 percent).
- The school division with the greatest proportion of 2018-19 public high school graduates who enrolled at NOVA during 2019-20 was the Manassas City school division (31 percent).

## Section 2. 2018-19 Northern Virginia Public High School Graduates Enrolled at NOVA by Nearest Campus: 2019-20

Section 2 displays 2018-19 Northern Virginia public high school graduates who enrolled at NOVA during 2019-20 by nearest campus. Data are organized by NOVA campus with affiliated high schools presented alphabetically.

Although high schools are affiliated with NOVA campuses due to their proximity, students may select any NOVA campus as their "home" campus. The number of graduates enrolled at NOVA are therefore also reported by NOVA "home" campus. The Medical Education Campus is not affiliated with any particular high school due to the specialized nature of its programs.

- The service area with the highest percentage of 2018-19 recent high school graduates who enrolled at NOVA was the Woodbridge Campus service area (27 percent).
- The high schools with the largest numbers of students enrolled at NOVA in 2019-20 were Battlefield (near the Manassas Campus, 179 students), Gar-Field (near the Woodbridge Campus, 173 students), Woodbridge Senior (near the Woodbridge Campus, 164 students), Forest Park (near the Woodbridge Campus, 164 students), C. D. Hylton (near the Woodbridge Campus, 161 students), and Annandale (near the Annandale Campus, 159 students).
