# 2019-20 Northern Virginia Public High School Graduates Enrolled at NOVA in 2020-21

This brief presents data on Northern Virginia public high school graduates who graduated in 2019-20 and enrolled at Northern Virginia Community College (NOVA) in 2020-21. The Northern Virginia region is of primary interest in this brief. This region encompasses eight public school divisions: Alexandria City, Arlington County, Fairfax County, Falls Church City, Loudoun County, Manassas City, Manassas Park City, and Prince William County.

## Section 1. 2019-20 Northern Virginia Public High School Graduates Enrolled at NOVA by School Division: 2020-21

Section 1 presents 2019-20 Northern Virginia public high school graduates who enrolled at NOVA during 2020-21 by school division. Data are organized by school division with affiliated high schools presented alphabetically.

- Overall, 26 percent of 2019-20 Northern Virginia high school graduates enrolled at NOVA in 2020-21.
- The three high schools with the greatest percentages of graduates who enrolled at NOVA were
  - o Forest Park (Prince William County school division, 38 percent),
  - Woodbridge Senior (Prince William County school division, 38 percent), and
  - Annandale (Fairfax County, 37 percent).
- The school division with the greatest proportion of 2019-20 public high school graduates who enrolled at NOVA during 2020-21 was the Prince William County school division (32 percent).

## Section 2. 2019-20 Northern Virginia Public High School Graduates Enrolled at NOVA by Nearest Campus: 2020-21

Section 2 displays 2019-20 Northern Virginia public high school graduates who enrolled at NOVA during 2020-21 by nearest campus. Data are organized by NOVA campus with affiliated high schools presented alphabetically.

Although high schools are affiliated with NOVA campuses due to their proximity, students may select any NOVA campus as their "home" campus. The number of graduates enrolled at NOVA are therefore also reported by NOVA "home" campus. The Medical Education Campus is not affiliated with any particular high school due to the specialized nature of its programs.

- The service area with the highest percentage of 2019-20 recent high school graduates who enrolled at NOVA in 2020-21 was the Woodbridge Campus service area (34 percent).
- The three high schools with the largest numbers of recent graduates enrolled at NOVA in 2020-21 were:
  - o Woodbridge Senior (near the Woodbridge Campus, 239 students),
  - o Battlefield (near the Manassas Campus, 226 students), and
  - Colgan (near the Woodbridge Campus, 223 students).
