Top Transfer Institutions by NOVA Degree Program: 2013-14 and 2014-15

This Research Brief presents data on the top transfer institutions by NOVA students entering institutions in the 2013-14 and 2014-15 academic years.

- **Table 1** displays the top transfer institutions of <u>any NOVA student</u> regardless of whether they first graduated with a NOVA degree.
 - The transfer institution with the largest number of NOVA students in 2013-14 and 2014-15 was George Mason University (28 and 29 percent, respectively).
- Tables 2 through 5 display the top transfer institutions of <u>NOVA graduates</u>.
 - The transfer institution with the largest number of NOVA graduates in both 2013-14 and 2014-15 was George Mason University (56 percent of transfers with NOVA degrees).
 - The NOVA degree program with the largest number of graduates transferring in both 2013-14 and 2014-15 was the General Studies A.S. program (26 percent of transfers with NOVA degrees).
