## Three-Year Transfer Analysis: Fall 2013 First-Time in College Cohort

The majority of NOVA students who transferred during the 2014-15 academic year transferred without first earning a NOVA credential. To better understand transfer student behavior, students in the Fall 2013 first-time in college (FTIC) cohort were tracked for three years from their time at NOVA to transfer at a four-year institution.

There were 8,211 FTIC<sup>1</sup> in Fall 2013.

- **Twenty percent**: Of the 8,211 FTIC in Fall 2013, 1,663 transferred to a four-year institution within three years of their initial enrollment at NOVA.
  - Of the 1,663 students who transferred within three years, 688 students (41 percent) graduated from NOVA with a degree or certificate prior to transfer.
  - Of the 1,663 students who transferred within three years, 975 students (59 percent) did so without earning a credential at NOVA (See Table 1 and Figure 1 next page).
    - Of the 975 who transferred without earning a credential, 455 students (47 percent) transferred within two semesters (fall and spring) of initial enrollment at NOVA.
    - Students who transferred after two semesters at NOVA enrolled in an average of 25 total credits prior to transfer.
    - Students who transferred after three semesters at NOVA enrolled in an average of 38 total credits prior to transfer.
- **Nine percent**: An additional 694 students earned a degree within three years of enrollment and did not transfer during that time.
- Twenty percent of the Fall 2013 FTIC cohort (1,635 students) remained enrolled at NOVA in Fall 2016<sup>2</sup>.
- **Fifty-one percent** of the Fall 2013 FTIC had not graduated, remained enrolled, or transferred to a four-year institution within three years.


