Recent Northern Virginia Public High School Graduates at NOVA: Fall 2013 and Fall 2014

This Research Brief compares the number of recent high school graduates from Northern Virginia public high schools who registered at NOVA during Fall 2013 and Fall 2014. Data are shown by nearest NOVA campus.

- As seen in Table 1, three out of five campuses showed an increase in the number of registered students from Fall 2013 to Fall 2014. The number of registered students at Alexandria, Loudoun, and Woodbridge Campuses each grew by 8 percent.
- Annandale and Manassas Campuses showed decreases of 6 and 5 percent, respectively.
- Overall, the number of recent Northern Virginia public high school graduates registering at NOVA increased by 2 percent from Fall 2013 to Fall 2014.

The number of recent high school graduates who registered at NOVA in Fall 2013 and Fall 2014, disaggregated by high school, can be found in Table 2 on the next page.

¹ Numbers include students who graduated from a Northern Virginia public high school between July 1, 2012 and June 30, 2013 and registered at NOVA for the Fall 2013 semester.

² Numbers include students who graduated from a Northern Virginia public high school between July 1, 2013 and June 30, 2014 and registered at NOVA for the Fall 2014 semester.

³ The 'Registered Fall 2014' total for Loudoun Campus includes 37 registrants from a new high school that was not included in Fall 2013 data and are not calculated in the number/percent difference for the Loudoun Campus.
