## 2014 Northern Virginia Public High School Graduates Who Applied to NOVA and Registered: Fall 2014

This Research Brief presents the number of 2014 Northern Virginia public high school graduates who applied to NOVA and those who registered in the Fall 2014 semester.<sup>1</sup> Data are shown by nearest NOVA campus.

Two columns of registered students are shown in the tables. The first, '# Registered out of Applied to NOVA', includes registered students from the Fall 2014 applicant list only (those who applied to NOVA specifically for Fall 2014). The second, 'Total 2014 HS Grads Registered', shows all 2014 high school graduates who were registered in Fall 2014, regardless of the term for which they applied. Therefore, the 'Total 2014 HS Grads Registered' column includes registered students from the Fall 2014 applicant list as well as from applicant lists from other terms (e.g., students who applied for Summer 2014, etc.).

- As seen in Table 1, the Annandale Campus had the highest percentage of recent public high school graduates who registered at NOVA among the Fall 2014 applicants from high schools in its service area (72 percent).
- College-wide, 68 percent of the Fall 2014 applicants registered for classes at NOVA in Fall 2014.

The number of recent public high school graduates who registered at NOVA in Fall 2014 and the number of Fall 2014 applicants, disaggregated by high school, can be found in Table 2 on the next page.

<sup>1</sup> These students graduated from a Northern Virginia public high school between July 1, 2013 and June 30, 2014 and registered at NOVA for the Fall 2014 semester.

<sup>2</sup> The 'Applied to NOVA for Fall 2014' column shows the number of recent high school graduates who indicated on their application that they intended to begin their studies at NOVA in Fall 2014.

<sup>3</sup> The '% Registered out of Applied to NOVA' column corresponds with the '# Registered out of Applied to NOVA' column and provides the percentage of students who were registered in Fall 2014 out of those who applied specifically for the Fall 2014 term.
