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# Point-in-Time Comparisons of Enrollment by Campus, Division, ELI, Session, and Discipline: Fall 2015 Versus Fall 2014 – August 25, 2015

# **Executive Summary**

The comparisons in this document are between corresponding points in time in Fall registration at NOVA. Registration is presented from Thursday, 8/21/2014 for Fall 2014 and from Tuesday, 8/25/2015 for Fall 2015. Both days are the day after the start of 16-Week and 1<sup>st</sup> 8-Week Classes.

# Section 1. FTES by Campus and Division

- There was a 3 percent decrease in overall College-wide FTES enrollment. (Table 1)
  - AL Campus (-496 FTES; -9%)
  - AN Campus (-345 FTES; -3%)
- The following campus divisions <u>decreased</u> the greatest in FTES<sup>1</sup>. (Table 2)
  - AN: Liberal Arts (-161 FTES; -6%), Languages and Literature (-77 FTES; -4%), and Mathematics, Science, and Engineering (-86 FTES; -3%)
  - LO: Communication and Human Studies (-96 FTES; -4%)
  - ME: Allied Health (-22 FTES; -4%)
  - WO: Arts, Communication, and Humanities (-118 FTES; -8%)

# Section 2. <u>ELI FTES</u> by Campus and Division

- ELI FTES <u>decreased</u> at four of the six campuses and <u>decreased</u> overall by 3 percent. (Table 3)
  - AN ELI (-103 FTES; -7%)
  - LO ELI (-43 FTES; -6%)
  - MA ELI (-6 FTES; -3%)
  - ME ELI (-16 FTES; -8%)
- The following campus divisions <u>decreased</u> the greatest in ELI FTES<sup>1</sup>: (Table 4)
  - AN ELI: Liberal Arts (-27 FTES; -6%), Languages and Literature (-19 FTES; -10%), and Mathematics, Science, and Engineering (-69 FTES; -13%)
  - LO ELI: Communication and Human Studies (-44 FTES; -10%)

# Section 3. FTES by Session and Campus

- FTES Enrollment decreased the greatest in the 16-Week Session: (Table 5)
  - AL: 16-Week Session (-614 FTES; -16%)
  - AN: 16-Week Session (-505 FTES; -7%)
  - WO: 16-Week Session (-218 FTES; -8%)

### Section 4. FTES by Campus, Division, and Discipline

- The following disciplines experienced the greatest <u>decreases</u> in FTES: (Tables 6-11)
  - o AL: BIO (-79 FTES), CSC (-40 FTES), ENG (-39 FTES), HIS (-48 FTES)
  - o AN: ITE (-35 FTES), ESL (-34 FTES), PHY (-33 FTES), PSY (-51 FTES)
  - LO: ESL (-28 FTES), HIS (-29 FTES), PSY (-17 FTES)
  - MA: CHD (-16 FTES), ITE (-10 FTES), PED (-11 FTES)
  - ME: EMS (-9 FTES), HIM (-11 FTES), RAD (-12 FTES)
  - WO: CST (-27 FTES), ESL (-45 FTES), MTT (-27 FTES), PSY (-28 FTES)
