Veterans Using Post-9/11 GI Bill Benefits at NOVA: 2012

This Research Note presents data on the number of veterans using Post-9/11 GI Bill benefits at NOVA in 2012. The data were retrieved from the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia. Table 1 and Figure 1 display the number and percentage of veterans using Post-9/11 GI Bill benefits at NOVA by campus in 2012. A total of 3,177 veterans using Post-9/11 GI Bill benefits attended NOVA in 2012. The Annandale (28%), Alexandria (27%), and Woodbridge (24%) Campuses had the highest enrollment of veterans using the Post-9/11 GI Bill benefits at NOVA in 2012.
