2015 Northern Virginia Public High School Graduates Who Applied to NOVA and Registered: Fall 2015

This Research Brief presents the number of 2015 Northern Virginia public high school graduates who applied to NOVA and those who registered in the Fall 2015 semester.¹ Data are shown by nearest NOVA campus.

Two columns of registered students are shown in the tables. The first, '# Registered out of Applied to NOVA', includes registered students from the Fall 2015 applicant list only (those who applied to NOVA specifically for Fall 2015). The second, 'Total 2015 HS Grads Registered', shows all 2015 high school graduates who were registered in Fall 2015, regardless of the term for which they applied. Therefore, the 'Total 2015 HS Grads Registered' column includes registered students from the Fall 2015 applicant list as well as from applicant lists from other terms (e.g., students who applied for Summer 2015, etc.).

- As seen in Table 1, the Annandale Campus had the highest percentage of recent public high school graduates who registered at NOVA among the Fall 2015 applicants from high schools in its service area (73 percent).
- College-wide, 66 percent of the Fall 2015 applicants registered for classes at NOVA in Fall 2015.

The number of recent public high school graduates who registered at NOVA in Fall 2015 and the number of Fall 2015 applicants, disaggregated by high school, can be found in Table 2 on the next page.

¹ These students graduated from a Northern Virginia public high school between July 1, 2014 and June 30, 2015 and registered at NOVA for the Fall 2015 semester.

² The 'Applied to NOVA for Fall 2015' column shows the number of recent high school graduates who indicated on their application that they intended to begin their studies at NOVA in Fall 2015.

³ The '% Registered out of Applied to NOVA' column corresponds with the '# Registered out of Applied to NOVA' column and provides the percentage of students who were registered in Fall 2015 out of those who applied specifically for the Fall 2015 term.
