Lower-Income ZIP Codes within NOVA's Service Area


Introduction

Community colleges serve as gateways to socio-economic mobility and opportunity for students. However, low-income, or underserved, students often lack the guidance and support they need to prepare for college, apply to college, obtain financial aid, enroll in courses, and graduate. Often times, these students are the first in their family to apply to college and may require more guidance and resources to successfully navigate college.

There are 12 ZIP codes in NOVA's service area with median annual incomes below \$80,000. Understanding the population and enrollment trends of these areas can help NOVA to improve student outreach, such as support in the application, financial aid, and enrollment processes. Additionally, enhanced advising services, financial stability services, and guidance through graduation can improve both access and success for this underserved population of potential students.

- ➤ **Population**: In the twelve ZIP codes in NOVA's service area with a median annual income below \$80,000, the population ages 15-44 is growing (5 percent). (Figure 1, next page)
 - o In nine of 12 ZIP codes, the population ages 15-44 increased from 2012 to 2016.
 - In six ZIP codes, the population ages 15-44 increased while NOVA enrollment of students ages 44 and under **decreased**. The largest gap was from Alexandria (22312) where there was a difference of 23 percentage points.
 - Triangle (22172) and Manassas (20110) are the only two ZIP codes where the population and NOVA enrollment increased at roughly the same rate.
- > NOVA Enrollment: In the twelve ZIP codes in NOVA's service area with a median annual income below \$80,000, NOVA enrollment of students ages 44 and under is decreasing (-4 percent). (Figure 1, next page)
 - In eight of 12 ZIP codes, NOVA enrollment of students ages 44 and under decreased from 2012 to 2016, each more than the overall service area average of -1 percent.
 - NOVA enrollment increased in four of these ZIP codes; however, Quantico (22134) was the only ZIP code with a higher percentage increase in NOVA enrollment than in the population.




Zip Codes with Median Household Income Below \$80k/Year

- ➤ **Draw Rate**: Over the past five years, NOVA is drawing students at lower rates in the twelve ZIP codes in NOVA's service area with a median annual income below \$80,000. (Figure 2, below)
 - In every ZIP code except Quantico (22134), the draw rate of NOVA students ages 44 and under out of the population ages 15-44 decreased from Fall 2012 to Fall 2016.
