Introduction

Northern Virginia Community College (NOVA) uses several measures to evaluate student achievement in support of its mission and strategic plan, which states a commitment to the values of access, opportunity, student success, and excellence. In particular, the College aims to provide students access to high-quality, postsecondary education in the Northern Virginia region, as well as to promote success by preparing students to graduate, transfer out, and enter the workforce with improved educational and labor market skills.

NOVA demonstrates its commitment to the values of student access and student success through well-established processes that are in place to evaluate and improve student achievement. In particular, NOVA measures eight student achievement criteria as reported to the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools Commission on Colleges (SACSCOC): 1) College Readiness; 2) Enrollment; 3) Course Success; 4) Retention; 5) Graduation; 6) Transfer; 7) Job Placement; and 8) Licensing Exams.

This report provides critical updates to an earlier report series examining students transferring out of NOVA. The present report shows trends in transfer rates over time (Section A), looks at the most popular transfer institutions for NOVA students (Section B), and explores popular major pairings at NOVA and four-year schools (Section C).

Transfer figures are based on data from both the State Council of Higher Education for Virginia (SCHEV) and the National Student Clearinghouse (NSC), as provided by Virginia's Community Colleges (VCCS).

This report indicates that while the number of NOVA students who transfer out has increased in recent years, and while the proportion of transferring students who identify as ethnic or racial minorities has also increased, the number of NOVA students who transfer with a credential has decreased. The report is intended to assist NOVA administrators, faculty, staff, and other stakeholders in helping the College to optimize its curricula and programs to benefit students as they navigate from NOVA to their transfer institutions and beyond.

Executive Summary

Section A. Transfer Trends

- The number of NOVA students transferring to a four-year institution increased by 28 percent between 2014-15 (9,200 students) and 2018-19 (11,773 students).
- 60 percent of NOVA transfers enroll at four-year institutions in Virginia.
- Fifty-nine percent of transfers to four-year institutions in Virginia in 2016-17 were of a minority race or ethnicity.
- The proportion of NOVA students who earned a degree or credential at NOVA prior to transferring declined by seven percentage points from 2014-15 to 2018-19 (from 35 to 28 percent).

Section B. Top Transfer Institutions

- Each year, the largest number of NOVA transfer students enroll at George Mason University (GMU). In 2018-19, over 3,000 NOVA students transferred to GMU.
- Fifty-nine percent of NOVA transfer students with a credential enroll at GMU. Seventeen percent of NOVA transfer students without a credential enroll at GMU.

Section C. Program Major Pairings at NOVA and Transfer Institutions

- Many students who transfer with a NOVA credential subsequently enroll in a related academic program at a four-year institution.
 - Among GMU transfers with the Business Administration, A.S. from NOVA, 26 percent (96 students) enrolled in Accounting, 24 percent (90 students) enrolled in Information Systems and Operations Management, 20 percent (73 students) enrolled in Management, and 13 percent (49 students) enrolled in Finance.
 - Among VCU transfers with the Science, A.S., 60 percent (18 students) enrolled in Biology.
 - Among VCU transfers with the Social Sciences, A.S., 30 percent (9 students) enrolled in Psychology, 13 percent (4 students) enrolled in Criminal Justice, and 13 percent (4 students) enrolled in Mass Communications.

Section A. Transfer Trends

The number of NOVA students who transfer to a four-year institution has increased over time.

- Nearly 12,000 NOVA students transferred to a four-year institution during the 2018-19 academic year, a 28 percent increase over 2014-15.
- Over 75 percent of transfers to four-year institutions in 2018-19 (9,200 students) transferred to a public institution rather than a private institution.
- The number of NOVA students transferring to a public institution increased by 40 percent from 2014-15 to 2018-19. Transfers to private institutions decreased by two percent during the same time period.





Figure 1. Transfers to Four-Year Institutions: 2014-15 through 2018-19



- Each year, over 60 percent of NOVA transfers enroll at a school located in Virginia.
- The number of students transferring to Virginia schools has increased steadily from 2014-15 through 2018-19.



In 2018-19, NOVA students transferred to four-year institutions in 49 of the 50 states as well as Washington, D.C., Puerto Rico, the Virgin Islands, and Canada. The only state where NOVA students did not enroll at a four-year transfer institution in 2018-19 was Wyoming.

Following Virginia (8,115 transfers), most NOVA transfers in 2018-19 enrolled at fouryear institutions in Washington, D.C. (471), Maryland (333), Pennsylvania (269), West Virginia (221), Florida (198), and New York (192).

Notably, the percentage of transfers of a minority race or ethnicity has increased steadily from 47 percent of transfers to four-year institutions in Virginia in 2012-13 to 59 percent in 2016-17.




Figure 4. Transfers to Four-Year Institutions in Virginia by Minority Status and Gender:

In addition to the transfer rate, the graduation rate is an important student achievement criterion. As such, NOVA is continually striving to provide its students with structure and supports that facilitate degree completion. Over time, the percentage of NOVA students who earn a degree or award prior to transferring has declined.

 In 2014-15, 35 percent of transfers completed a NOVA degree or award before transferring. By 2018-19, the figure had decreased by seven percentage points, to 28 percent.

The implementation of guided pathways and the creation of the ADVANCE partnership with George Mason University (GMU) are expected to help limit this decline and increase the number of students who earn a NOVA degree or award before transferring to a four-year institution.

• Each year, over 75 percent of students who complete a NOVA degree or award before transferring earn an A.S. degree.

Section B: Top Transfer Institutions

This section presents data on the most popular transfer institutions for NOVA students.

Each year, the largest number of NOVA transfer students enroll at George Mason University (GMU). In 2018-19, over 3,000 NOVA students transferred to GMU. The other top transfer institutions in 2018-19 were Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU), James Madison University (JMU), Virginia Polytechnic Institute and State University (Virginia Tech), and the University of Virginia (UVA). See Appendix A (public institutions) and Appendix B (private institutions) for complete lists of transfer institutions from 2014-15 through 2018-19.





Figure 6. Top 5 Transfer Institutions: 2014-15 through 2018-19

Among private, non-profit four-year transfer institutions, the largest number of NOVA students transferred to Liberty University (LU), Marymount University (MU), and George Washington University (GWU).



Students who transfer after earning a NOVA credential are more likely to enroll at certain fouryear institutions compared to students who transfer before earning a degree or certificate at NOVA.

- 59 percent of students who transferred with a NOVA credential enrolled at GMU in 2018-19 compared to 17 percent of transfers without a credential.
- A larger number of students without a NOVA credential transferred to VCU, JMU, and Virginia Tech compared to students with a NOVA credential.

Section C: Program Major Pairings at NOVA and Transfer Institutions

This section addresses the relationship between programs of study at NOVA and at popular transfer schools. An examination of these patterns in program enrollment can assist NOVA administrators with the creation of additional transfer pathways to the most popular transfer institutions.

The top ten transfer institutions for students who transferred in 2018-19 after earning a NOVA credential are listed in Table 4. The table presents transfer enrollments by NOVA award.

Through an examination of data showing the relationship between NOVA credentials and subsequent transfer institutions, the administration can continue to better prepare students for transfer success. In Fall 2018, NOVA implemented guided pathways to help ease the transition for students to four-year institutions. The pathways are designed to reduce the number of excess credits earned and allow for a seamless transfer of credits to select transfer partners. The pathways align with programs at several of the most popular transfer institutions for NOVA students.

The following tables explore the relationship between some of the most popular majors at NOVA and the three most popular transfer institutions for students who earn a NOVA credential prior to transfer: GMU, VCU, and GWU.

George Mason University

Table 4 (pages 8-9) showed the most popular NOVA credentials earned prior to transfer to GMU in 2018-19. Table 5 below shows which majors these students entered into upon enrollment at GMU. As the ADVANCE partnership between the two institutions continues to expand to include more programs, there is expected to be greater alignment between NOVA credentials and majors at GMU.

Many students who earned NOVA credentials subsequently enrolled in related programs at GMU.

 Among transfers with the A.S. in Business Administration, 26 percent (96 students) enrolled in Accounting, 24 percent (90 students) enrolled in Information Systems and Operations Management, 20 percent (73 students) enrolled in Management, and 13 percent (49 students) enrolled in Finance.

Of the NOVA graduates who transferred to VCU in 2018-19, 86 percent (157 students) earned one of the six credentials listed in Table 6. After the General Studies, A.S., the most popular NOVA degrees were the Science, A.S. and Social Sciences, A.S.

- Among transfers with the A.S. in Science, 60 percent (18 students) enrolled in Biology at VCU.
- Among transfers with the A.S. in Social Sciences, 30 percent (9 students) enrolled in Psychology, 13 percent (4 students) enrolled in Criminal Justice, and 13 percent (4 students) enrolled in Mass Communications.

Of the 112 NOVA graduates who enrolled at GWU in 2018-19, 91 (81 percent) earned one of the four NOVA credentials presented in Table 7.

• Cybersecurity; Integrated Information, Science, and Technology; and nursing-related programs were the most popular majors at GWU.

Many NOVA students do not complete a degree or certificate before transferring to another institution. These students might have planned to enroll at NOVA for only a short time, or they may have changed their academic plans and goals during the course of their NOVA enrollment.

As shown in Table 3 (page 7), the most popular transfer institutions in 2018-19 among NOVA students who did not earn a credential before transferring were GMU (1,451 transfers), VCU (787 transfers), and JMU (748 transfers). The following tables explore the most popular majors at these institutions among transfers without a NOVA credential, which can help inform the creation of additional transfer pathways.

George Mason University

The largest percentage of NOVA students who transferred to GMU without a credential enrolled without declaring a major (178 students, 12 percent). Computer Science was the most popular major (104 students, 7 percent), followed by Information Technology (89 students, 6 percent) and Biology (87 students, 6 percent).

Virginia Commonwealth University

The most popular major at VCU among NOVA transfers without a credential in 2018-19 was Biology (118 students, 15 percent). Business and Nursing were among the top three majors (13 percent and 7 percent, respectively).

James Madison University

Most NOVA transfers without a credential who enrolled at JMU did not declare a major (242 students, 32 percent). The most popular major at JMU among NOVA students who transferred without a credential in 2018-19 was Nursing (46 students, 6 percent). Four percent of students enrolled in both Marketing and Computer Science (32 and 30 students, respectively).

Conclusion

As NOVA works to better understand student transfer behavior and seeks to facilitate the transfer process, it is imperative that the College strive to prepare students for their education beyond NOVA. The data presented in this report showed the variety of diverse institutions that NOVA students attend upon transferring, as well as the unique majors in which they enroll.

It is essential for NOVA stakeholders to gain further insight into the transfer trends and patterns of the College's students. This report shows that the number of NOVA students who transfer-out has increased recently, and that the number of transfer-out students who identify as being of minority race or ethnicity has also increased. However, the report also indicates that the number of NOVA students who earn a credential at the College before transferring has decreased substantially in recent years.

The analysis presented in this report provides extensive data regarding the transfer patterns of students who either graduate from NOVA before transferring or who leave NOVA without earning a degree. This information is intended to be helpful in further optimizing programs like the ADVANCE collaboration between NOVA and its most popular transfer institution, George Mason University, a program that shows early signs of success. Information about students' transfer patterns, including transfer with or without a credential, transfer institution, and major or program selection upon transfer can aid NOVA's faculty and staff in planning pathway improvements.

All students can benefit from having clear pathways when transferring from community college to four-year institutions. While not all students earn a credential before they transfer, research suggests that community college students who earn associate degrees may be better-positioned not only for transfer but also for their working lives beyond college. This is partly because students who transfer without first earning a degree may be unable to transfer all of the credits that they earned while attending community college. Furthermore, sub-baccalaureate educational attainment in the form of earning degrees and other credentials is associated with higher lifetime earnings compared to earning a high school diploma only. This research report has contributed to the field of analysis through an examination of transfer students' major selections while at the College, as well as their transfer patterns, either with or without a degree or credential, beyond their learning experiences at NOVA.
