Employment Outcomes of NOVA Graduates: Business Management, A.A.S. and Certificate Programs

Introduction

This Research Brief presents the employment outcomes of 289 NOVA graduates of the Business Management, A.A.S. and Certificate programs from 2007 through 2017 (Section I) and provides employment data for Business Management (A.S. and B.S.) graduates (Section II).1 The employment data includes target occupations, job postings, companies hiring, and highly desired job skills and qualifications for Business Management (A.S. and B.S.) graduates in the NOVA region during the specified period.²

Data were extracted utilizing the Economic Modeling Specialists International (EMSI) product, which provides employment data derived from government sources, online job posting activity, and professional networking profiles (e.g., LinkedIn) and résumés. EMSI employment data were also used to determine the employment outcomes and workforce credentials of NOVA graduates.3

Key Findings

- The vast majority of NOVA Business Management (A.A.S. and Certificate) graduates are employed in a Business Management-related field (95 percent).
- The employment opportunities for Business Management (A.S. and B.S.) graduates in the NOVA region are favorable for some target occupations including Management Analysts, Business Operations Specialists, General and Operations Managers, Accountants and Auditors, and Managers.
 - Regionally, these target occupations have frequent job openings and median hourly earnings higher than national median hourly earnings for these occupations.
- Anthem, Oracle Corporation, Booz Allen Hamilton, Deloitte, and Leidos Holdings are the top five companies hiring Business Management (A.S. and B.S.) graduates in the NOVA region.

Section I. Employment Outcomes of NOVA Graduates

This section provides recent (2019) employment outcomes information for 289 NOVA graduates of the Business Management, A.A.S. and Certificate programs who graduated from 2007 through 2017.⁴ Of these graduates, the vast majority (95 percent) were employed in a Business Management-related occupation, and 59 percent resided within the NOVA region.⁵ The average estimated annual salary among these graduates (\$73,838) was higher than the average estimated annual salary for *all* NOVA graduates (\$66,652) from 2007 through 2017 (Figure 1).

Alumni Occupations

The top in-field occupations of NOVA's Business Management, A.A.S. and Certificate program graduates were Secretaries and Administrative Assistants (7 percent), Customer Service Representatives (3 percent), First-Line Supervisors of Office and Administrative Support Workers (3 percent), and non-specific Managers (3 percent) (Table 1).⁶

Employers and Job Titles of Alumni

The top employers of NOVA's Business Management, A.A.S. and Certificate program graduates included Caci International (2 percent), and Navy Federal Credit Union (2 percent) (Table 2).


Alumni Skills

The top hard and common skills of NOVA's Business Management, A.A.S. and Certificate program graduates included management (47 percent), customer service (34 percent), sales (26 percent), finance (24 percent), and Microsoft Excel (24 percent) (Table 4 and Figure 2).

Alumni Locations

The top locations where NOVA's Business Management, A.A.S. and Certificate program graduates resided included Washington, D.C. (25 percent), Alexandria, VA (9 percent), Woodbridge, VA (8 percent), Manassas, VA (5 percent), Arlington, VA (5 percent), and Springfield, VA (5 percent)—58 percent resided in the state of Virginia (Table 5 and Figure 3, below).

Section II. Regional Employment Opportunities for NOVA Graduates

This section presents regional employment opportunities data and provides job postings for target occupations within the NOVA region for Business Management (A.S. and B.S.) graduates.⁸

Target Occupations

In 2018, regionally, there were roughly 380,000 jobs and 42,000 job openings in the top ten target occupations for Business Management (A.S. and B.S.) graduates. Among these target occupations, median hourly earnings were \$32.73—60 percent higher than the \$20.40 national median hourly earnings for these target occupations. The projected regional job growth among these target occupations is 1 percent from 2018 to 2023, which is equivalent to the projected national growth for these target occupations (1 percent). Annual job openings for target occupations for Business Management (A.S. and B.S.) graduates were greatest for Management Analysts (2,822 openings) and Business Operations Specialists (2,471 openings) (Table 6).

For example, an occupation that makes up 10 percent of employment in a specific metropolitan area compared with 2 percent of U.S. employment would have a location quotient of 5 for the area (signifying the occupation is roughly 5 times more concentrated regionally than nationally).




Figure 4. NOVA Region Job Hires in Top 10 Target Occupations: 2018

From January 2018 through December 2018, there was an average of about 15,000 Business Management graduates hired monthly for target occupations in the NOVA region.¹⁰ Occupations with the top average monthly job hires were Retail Salespersons (3,034 hires) and Office Clerks (1,934 hires) (Table 7, below, and Figure 4, next page).


Job Postings in NOVA Region

Companies in the NOVA region with the most job postings from January 2018 through December 2018 for Business Management (A.S. and B.S.) graduates included Anthem (8,473 postings), Oracle Corporation (5,320 postings), Booz Allen Hamilton Holding Corporation (4,998 postings), Deloitte (3,459 postings), and Leidos Holdings (2,628 postings) (Table 9 and Figure 5, below).

Job Titles in NOVA Region

From January 2018 through December 2018, the most frequently posted job titles for Business Management (A.S. and B.S.) graduates in the NOVA region were for Business Analysts (4,869 postings), Project Managers (4,482 postings), Program Managers (4,319 postings), and Financial Analysts (4,240 postings) (Table 10 and Figure 6, below).

Figure 6. Top 20 Posted Job Titles in the NOVA Region: 2018




Desired Hard Skills

Table 11 and Figure 7 (below) show disproportions between the top *hard* skills that NOVA region employers sought among their job applicants and the hard skills that Business Management (A.S. and B.S.) graduates mentioned in their job-seeker profiles from January 2018 through December 2018.¹¹ Accounting, Auditing, and Forecasting were among the most desired hard skills in job postings that were disproportionately mentioned in job-seeker profiles. These differences represent potential areas in which job applicants could align their hard skills more closely with their prospective employers' desired skills.


Desired Common Skills

Table 12 and Figure 8 (below) show disproportions between the top *common* skills that NOVA region employers sought among their job applicants and the common skills that Business Management (A.S. and B.S.) graduates mentioned in their job-seeker profiles from January 2018 through December 2018. Communications, presentations, written communication, and problem solving were among the most desired common skills in job postings that were disproportionately mentioned in job-seeker profiles. These differences represent potential areas in which job applicants could align their common skills more closely with their prospective employers' desired skills.

The top desired qualifications for Business Management (A.S. and B.S.) graduates in NOVA region job postings from January 2018 through December 2018 included Master of Business Administration (10,934 postings), Project Management Professional Certification (6,910 postings), and Certified Public Accountant (5,776 postings) (Table 13 and Figure 9, below).
