NOVA is pleased to host three supplemental, fee-for-service programs at selected NOVA campuses that provide specialized resources and supports for our students with disabilities.

Adaptive College Experience (ACE) program, LO Campus – Sign up now!

The ACE program consists of twice-monthly, 50-minute group sessions led by Dr. Sajjad Khan, a licensed clinician and researcher, designed to support students with disabilities who would benefit from supplemental group coaching services. Fees for service may be reimbursable by health insurance plans. Group sessions will cover:

- **Executive Function Training** (organization, time management, selective attention)
- **Self-Regulation Training** (impulse control, mood regulation)
- **Social Skills Coaching** (self-advocacy, cooperative engagement, peer relations)
