Required Understanding Title IX: Sexual Misconduct, Discrimination & Support Continue



This training introduces students to Title IX, the federal law that protects against sex-based discrimination in education. Throughout the experience, you'll explore how Title IX applies to real situations on campus, what behaviors are prohibited, and how to recognize when something isn't right.

You'll also learn what consent means, how to respond if you or someone else experiences misconduct, and what support and reporting options are available. By the end, you'll have a clearer understanding of how you can help create a safer, more respectful campus environment.

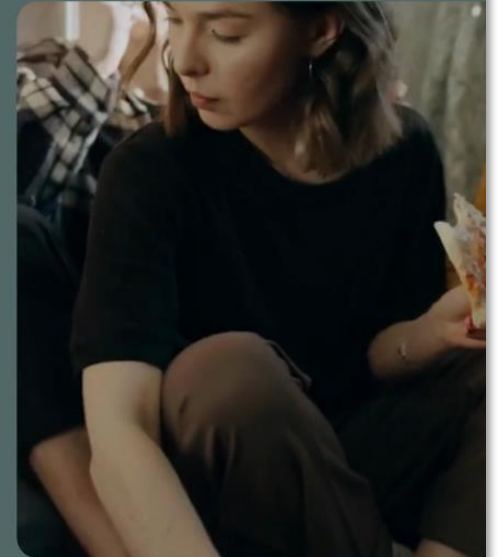

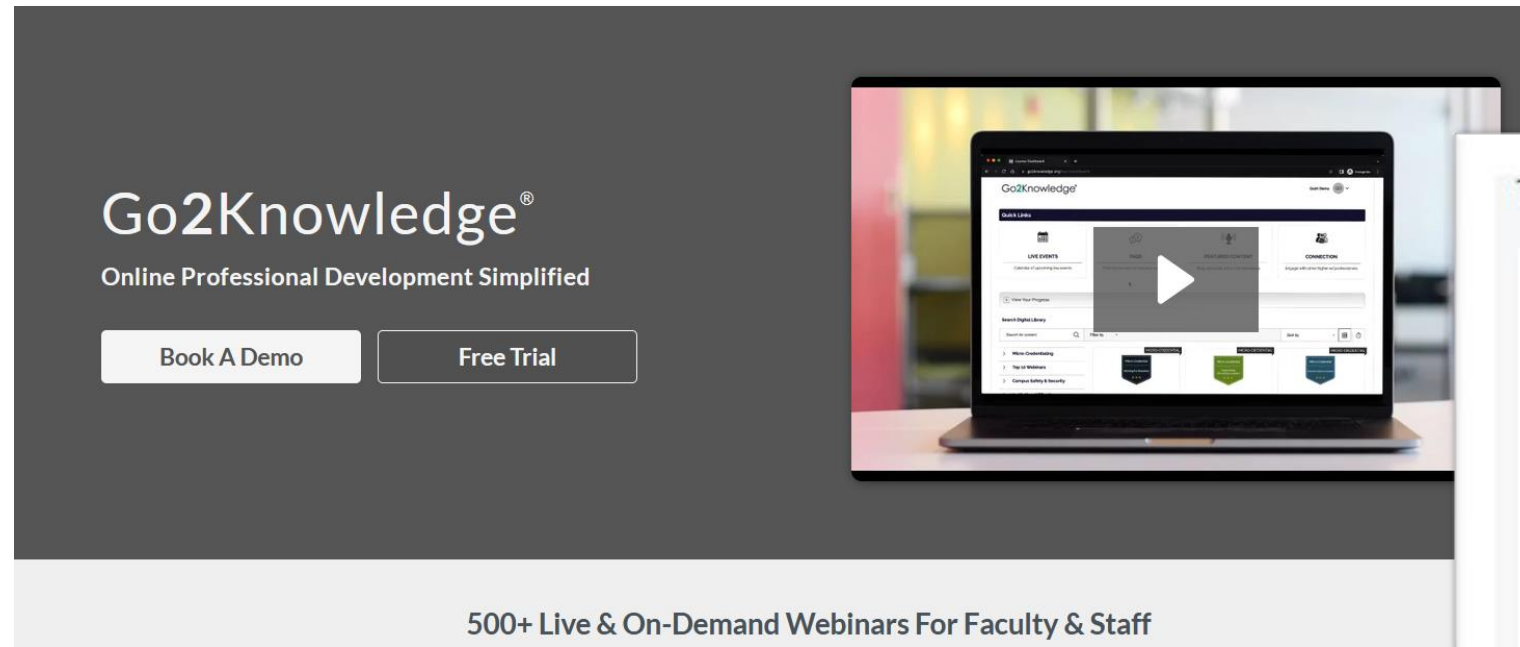

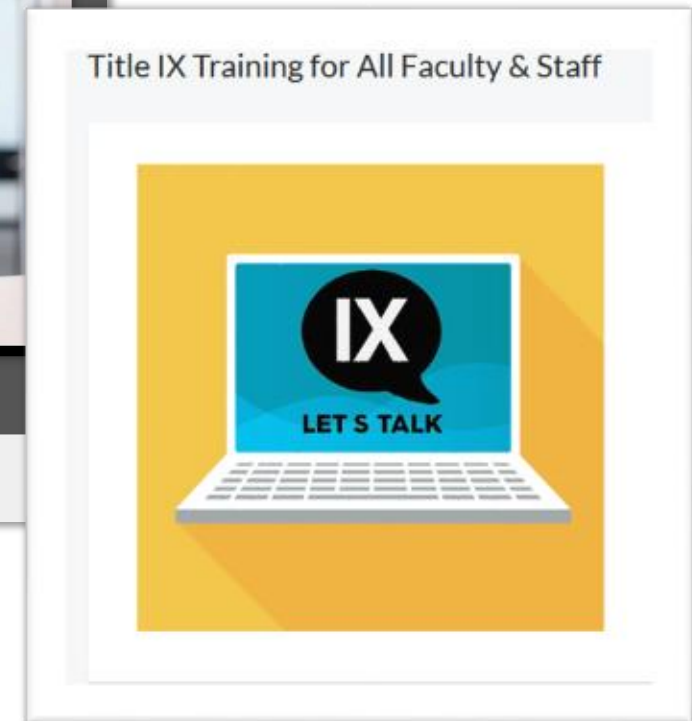
