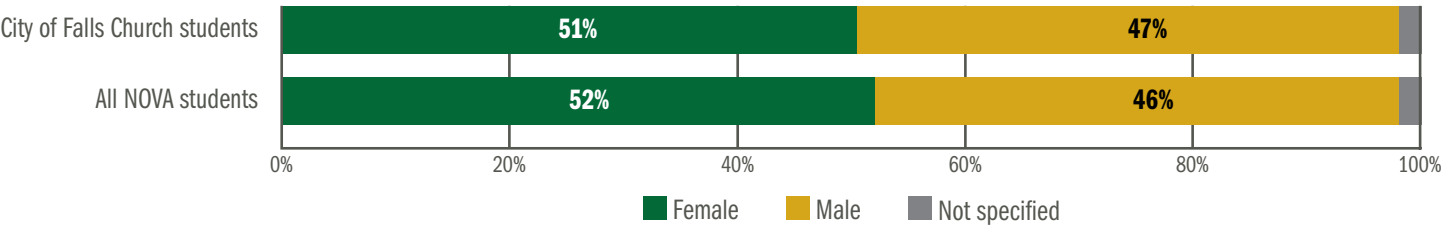

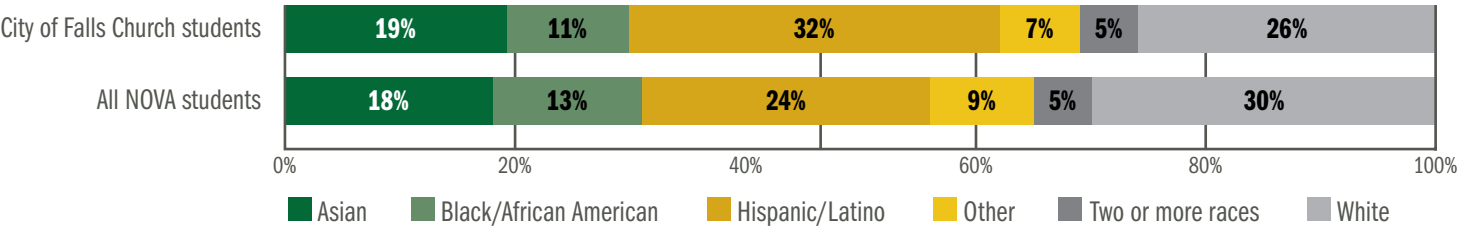

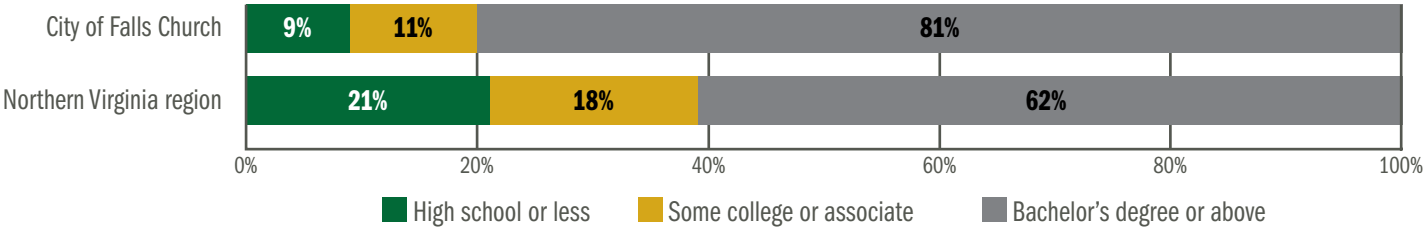
Gender of enrolled students (credit only)

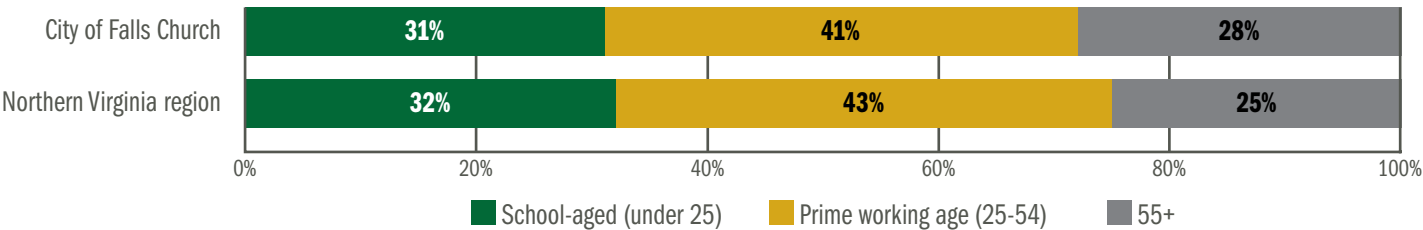

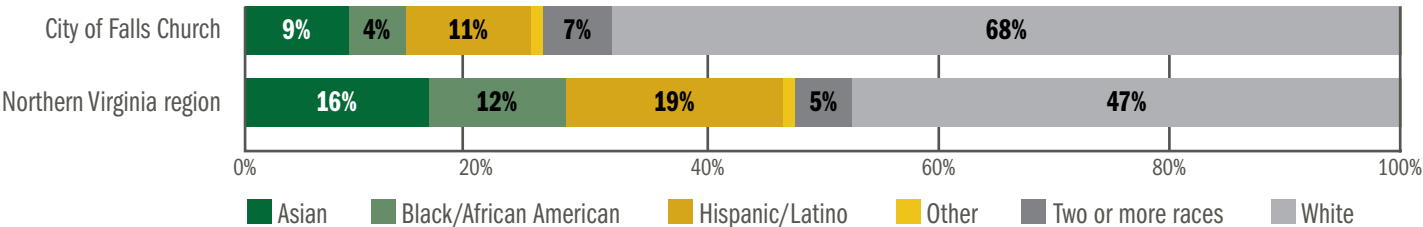
