Introduction

This Report presents student enrollment and success data for the ESL program. ESL courses are offered at Alexandria, Annandale, Loudoun, Manassas, and Woodbridge campuses and ELI. Section 1 provides unduplicated enrollment data on students in the ESL program for Fall 2012 through Spring 2017. Data are disaggregated by gender, race, age, enrollment status, campus, modality, day/night status, and session.

Section 2 presents student success data for the ESL program from Fall 2012 through Spring 2017. Student success data includes successful course completion rates disaggregated by campus, modality, and session.
