- Students who have graduated with an associate, baccalaureate, or higher degree from a regionally accredited United States institution of higher education have fulfilled the SDV requirement. Evaluation through the College Records Office must be requested to receive SDV transfer credit
- Applicants with pending transfer credit after the deadline will not be considered for admission. All international transcripts must be evaluated by IERF or WES prior to being sent to the College Records Office.
- Applicants must be at least 18 years of age or older to attend clinicals
- Program cohort sizes are approximate and may change depending on clinical site availability

**Please note that, per VCCS policy, a previous grade of a "P+" denotes that the student passed the course with a grade of a "C" or higher.
