Attend a 3-day professional learning series at NOVA's data center training facility in Woodbridge, VA, led by experienced industry professionals.



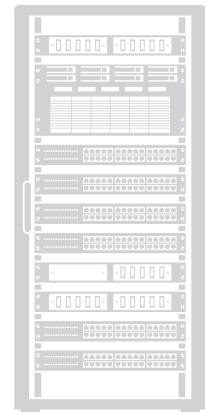
Complete a 5-day externship at an operational data center nearest their college that results in producing an educational action plan for integrating data center operations content into their professional practice.

Program stipends will be paid in two installments, totalling **\$3,500**.
