Spring 2026 registration opens on October 27, 2025

- DMS 100 and RAD 105 are high demand courses that fill quickly
- Spring sections reserved for applicants will require Department Consent (DC);
 if filled they will use a waitlist maintained by Diagnostic Imaging
- Applicants must have all requirements completed or be enrolled in final requirements for Spring to be approved for a reserved section
- Open sections will use a SIS waitlist once they have filled | How to Add to SIS Waitlist
 The college will close SIS waitlists approximately one week before class begins. After that happens, students may keep checking through the <u>Last Day to Add</u> for any openings

If it is AFTER 12:01 am on October 27, 2025, AND you are an applicant planning to apply in May requesting a reserved section:

IMPORTANT! Check your VCCS email daily! Applicants will have very limited time to register. If you do not use the class permission by its expiration date, you must send a new request.

Top Reasons for Unsuccessful Registration

TIME CONFLICTS

 Do not sign up for another class at the same day and time! You will not be contacted to clear a time conflict

COLLEGE HOLDS

- Check for any <u>holds</u> that stop registration
 - o Financial | Admission | Parking Tickets
 - New Student Training (first-time students must complete <u>New Student Training on Canvas</u>)

SDV 100 OR 101 IN FIRST SEMESTER

- Degree students must take SDV 100 or SDV 101 their first semester
- Students with previous degrees or who have taken an equivalent course outside NOVA may refer to the SDV exemption directions

MISSING INFORMATION

• Provide all requested information – emails missing information will not be processed

ASKING FOR A RESERVED SECTION BUT MISSING REQUIREMENTS

- Make sure you are registered for any final requirements prior to emailing Diagnostic Imaging
- Applicants transferring requirements must have already submitted <u>Form 125-049 Transfer</u>
 <u>Credit Evaluation Request</u> or attach an unofficial transcript showing the transfer credit

Spring Tuition Payment Deadline – currently January 6, 2026

- Check the <u>Spring 2026 Academic Calendar</u> for any updates
- Have final payment arrangements in place by this date
- Students dropped for non-payment will lose their seat

Note: If there are any openings in the reserved sections after January 12, 2026, they will be opened on SIS to all students.
