NOVA COLLEGE-WIDE COURSE CONTENT SUMMARY ADJ 127 - FIREARMS AND MARKSMANSHIP (3 CR.)

Course Description

Surveys lethal weapons in current use and current views on weapon types and ammunition design. Examines the legal guidelines as to use of deadly force, safety in handling of weaponry, and weapon care and cleaning; marksmanship instruction under standard range conditions. Lecture 2 hours. Laboratory 3 hours. Total 5 hours per week.

General Course Purpose

The purpose of this course is to provide the student with knowledge of the handling and operation of various firearms and the legal and moral responsibilities attendant to him/her.
