ARA 112 - CONVERSATION IN ARABIC II (3 CR.)**

COURSE DESCRIPTION

Continuation of Arabic 111. Emphasizes the spoken language, stressing fluency and correctness of structure, pronunciation, and vocabulary. Topics and structures will be more complex.

Lecture - 3 hours per week

GENERAL COURSE PURPOSE

This course provides continued practice in speaking and understanding Arabic, with emphasis upon developing fluency, increasing vocabulary and improving sentence structure and pronunciation.

ENTRY LEVEL COMPETENCIES

The prerequisite for this course is ARA 102 – "Beginning Arabic II" or ARA 111 or equivalent.

COURSE OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, the student should be able to handle successfully a variety of uncomplicated tasks and social.

- B. Making purchases
- C. Using the telephone
- D. Ordering a meal
- E. Current events
- F. Handle simple transactions, e.g. hotel, restaurant, post office, bank, drugstore
- G. Autobiographical information
- H. Leisure time activities
- I. Narrations about past, present, and future activities
- J. Reports on current events and factual information
