Course Description

Covers whole number principles and computations. Credits not applicable toward graduation. Lecture ${\bf 1}$ hour per week.

General Course Purpose

This course is designed to serve the needs of students who need to develop computational skills with whole numbers prior to enrolling in an MTT course.

Course Objectives

Upon completing the course, students will be able to:

- Recognize place value and names for numbers
- Perform operations with whole numbers
- Round whole numbers and estimate with whole numbers
- Solve application problems by adding, subtracting, multiplying, or dividing whole numbers

- Addition, Subtraction, Multiplication, Division
- Rounding and Estimation
