EMS 245 – ALS FIELD INTERNSHIP IV (1 CR.)**

**Course Description**

Continues with the fourth in a series of field experiences providing supervised direct patient care in out-of-hospital advanced life support units. May be repeated as needed. Laboratory 3 hours per week.

**General Course Purpose**

This course is the culmination of DOT's National Paramedic curriculum. The ALS Field Internship provides supervised opportunities for paramedic students to assess and manage all types of pre-hospital patients.

**Entry Level Competencies**

Prerequisite: EMT/B Certification

**Course Goals and Objectives**

After successful completion of the course, paramedic students will be capable of demonstrating how to serve as a team leader in a variety of pre-hospital emergency situations on at least 50 pre-hospital responses.

**Objectives**

Demonstrate how to serve as a team leader in a variety of pre-hospital emergency situations on at least 50 prehospital responses.

**Major Topics to be Included**

Multiple rotations on an out-of-hospital advanced life support unit under the direct supervision of a preceptor.
