## **NVCC COLLEGE-WIDE COURSE CONTENT SUMMARY**

### **FRE 111 - CONVERSATION IN FRENCH I (3 CR.)**

#### **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

Emphasizes the spoken language, stressing fluency and correctness of structure, pronunciation and vocabulary. Lecture 3 hours per week.

#### **GENERAL COURSE PURPOSE**

This course provides practice in speaking and understanding French, with emphasis upon developing fluency, increasing vocabulary and improving sentence structure.

#### **ENTRY LEVEL COMPETENCY**

The prerequisite for this course is FRE 102 – “Beginning French II” or equivalent (or permission of instructor).

#### **COURSE OBJECTIVES**

Upon completion of this course students should be able to initiate, sustain and close conversations in a range of circumstances and covering a variety of topics. Students will improve their pronunciation.

#### **MAJOR TOPICS TO BE COVERED**

Everyday situations which may include:

- A. Introductions
- B. Asking for directions
- C. Making purchases
- D. Using the telephone
- E. Ordering a meal
- F. Current events
- G. Culture
