# NVCC COLLEGE-WIDE COURSE CONTENT SUMMARY ITA 104 - BASIC SPOKEN ITALIAN II (3 CR.)

# **COURSE DESCRIPTION**

Teaches oral communication and introduces cultural mores and customs to students with basic conversational skills.

Lecture - 3 hours per week

## **GENERAL COURSE PURPOSE**

Basic Spoken Italian II is a conversational course for students with some previous Italian. The focus is on communication skills, practical vocabulary and cultural patterns. There are brief, simplified explanations of the structure of the language.

## ENTRY LEVEL COMPETENCY

The prerequisite for this course is ITA 103 – "Basic Spoken Italian I" or equivalent.

## COURSE OBJECTIVES

Upon completion of this course, the student will be able to:

Understand simple spoken Italian within the limited context, Carry on a simple conversation with correct pronunciation, Read the Italian the student has already learned to comprehend and speak, Be aware of cultural patterns, including social patterns of behavior and current events.
