NOVA COLLEGE-WIDE COURSE CONTENT SUMMARY POR 103 – BASIC SPOKEN PORTUGUESE I (3 CR.)

Course Description

Teaches oral communication and introduces cultural mores and customs to students with no prior instruction in the language. Lecture 3 hours per week.

General Course Purpose

Basic Spoken Portuguese I is a conversational course for students with no previous Portuguese. The focus is on communication skills, practical vocabulary, and cultural patterns. There are brief, simplified explanations of the structure of the language. This course does not fulfill the foreign language requirement for the AA degree.
