# NOVA COLLEGE-WIDE COURSE CONTENT SUMMARY RTH 254 - ADVANCED CLINICAL PROCEDURES IV (3 CR.)

### **Course Information**

Offers clinical instruction in advanced patient care practice. Clinical 15 hours per week.

## **General Course Purpose**

This course is offered in the fifth and final semester of the respiratory therapy program. The student is expected to function as a critical care therapist with limited supervision or instruction. The student should be able to correlate all classroom material received to this point with situations in the critical care setting.

### Course Prerequisites/Corequisites

Prerequisites: RTH and completion of all preceding RTH courses or permission of the assistant dean. Students must demonstrate competence in basic respiratory therapy instrumentation.

#### **Course Objectives**

Upon completion of this course the student must demonstrate proficiency in the following:

- A. Clinical application of mechanical ventilation graphics
- B. Cardiopulmonary assessment
- C. Advanced physiologic monitoring

#### **Major Topics**

- A. Ventilatory weaning parameters
- B. Pulmonary function testing
- C. Patient assessment in critical care settings
