E-Summer Program @NOVA



Sponsored by the Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities and Dominion Energy, The E-Summer Program @ NOVA is designed to introduce Hispanic and underrepresented minority students to STEM and the energy industry. Rising juniors and seniors who meet qualifying GPA or test score requirements may apply. Students will be offered two courses at no cost: CSC 221: Introduction to Problem Solving and Programming (3cr) and SDV 100: College Success Skills (1cr), earning four college credits over the six-week program. Students must take both courses.

The program will be held at NOVA's Alexandria, Manassas and Woodbridge Campus over six weeks, starting July 1. Students must select their preferred campus. Classes will be in a hybrid format – on-campus on Mondays and Wednesdays from 9 a.m.-1:00 p.m. and virtual (via zoom) on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 9 a.m.-11 a.m. Attendance is mandatory at all in-person and virtual class sessions.

In addition to course content, students will learn from industry speakers about the energy industry and career opportunities, participate in a field trip to a Dominion Energy facility and learn about NOVA support resources and the benefits of higher education. Lunch will be provided on Mondays and Wednesdays.
