



## READ&WRITE FOR GOOGLE CHROME


1) Search “Read&Write for Google Chrome” and select the link:



2) It will bring you to the chrome web store, click “Add to Chrome”



3) A text box will pop up, select “Add Extension”



- 4) The Read Write extension will be at the left of your search bar. Select it anytime you want something read in Canvas, your email or anywhere on the web. The toolbar will appear and you can press play.
