- Students must complete the application requirements by the deadline to apply
- Meeting the minimum application requirements does not guarantee acceptance
- Application periods open at midnight on the start date and close at 11:59 pm on the end date
- College Science courses (BIO, CHM, NAS) must be within past 10 years unless otherwise stated
- Students who have graduated with an associate, baccalaureate or higher degree from a regionally accredited United States institution of higher education have fulfilled the SDV requirement.
Evaluation through the College Records Office must be requested to receive SDV transfer credit
- Applicants must be at least 18 years of age or older to attend clinicals
- Program cohort sizes are approximate and may change depending on clinical site availability
