

**ADMISSION AND CONTINUED ENROLLMENT OF STUDENTS WHO MAY POSE A THREAT**

**1. Scope**

This policy applies to prospective or current students who are registered sex offenders; to students who may pose a threat; and to students who have had an XTA service indicator placed on their record by another VCCS college.

**2. Policy Statement**

Northern Virginia Community College reserves the right to evaluate all applications for admission, document special cases, and to refuse or revoke admission if the College determines that the applicant or student is a threat, is a potential danger, is significantly disruptive to the college community, or if such refusal is considered to be in the best interest of the College. Students whose admission is revoked after enrollment must be given due process.

**3. Definitions**

ALL Service Indicator: The ALL service indicator is placed on a student's record when a student is dismissed from the College due to misconduct, exhibits threatening behavior, or is determined to be a potential threat. The indicator prevents enrollment at Northern Virginia Community College, but does not prohibit the student from enrolling at other VCCS colleges who do not have this minimum admissions criteria.

Current student: A student who is currently enrolled or who has been enrolled within the last year.

Prospective student: An individual who has applied, or seeks to apply, to the College but has not yet attended class.

Sex Offender: A person for whom registration on the Virginia Criminal Information Network, Sexual Offender Registry and/or the National Crime Information Center, Convicted Sexual Offender Registry is a mandatory requirement; or is a person registered as a sex offender pursuant to Virginia Code § 9.1-901 and § 9.1-902.

XTA Service Indicator: The XTA service indicator is placed on a student's record when a student is dismissed for misconduct, exhibits threatening behavior, or is determined to be a potential threat. The indicator prevents enrollment at all VCCS colleges.
