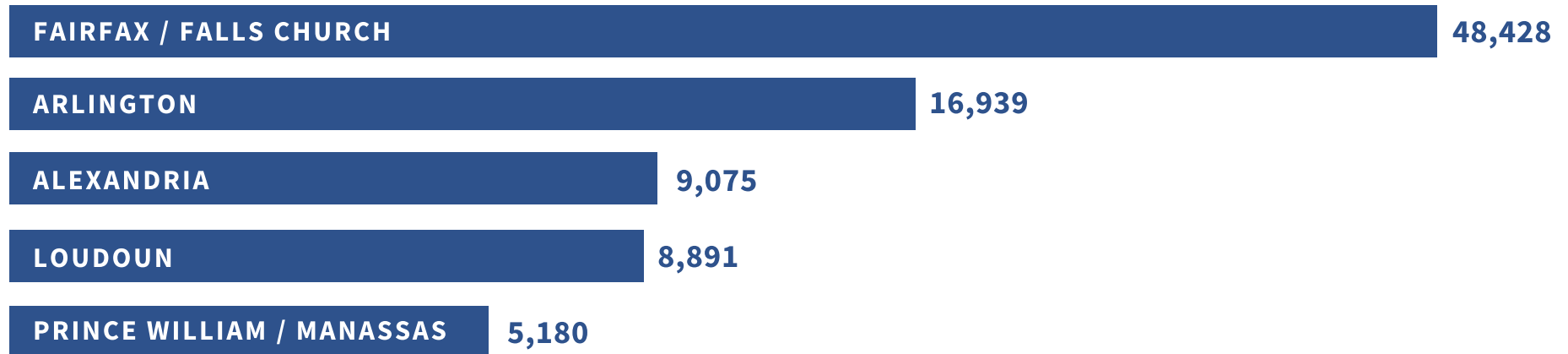

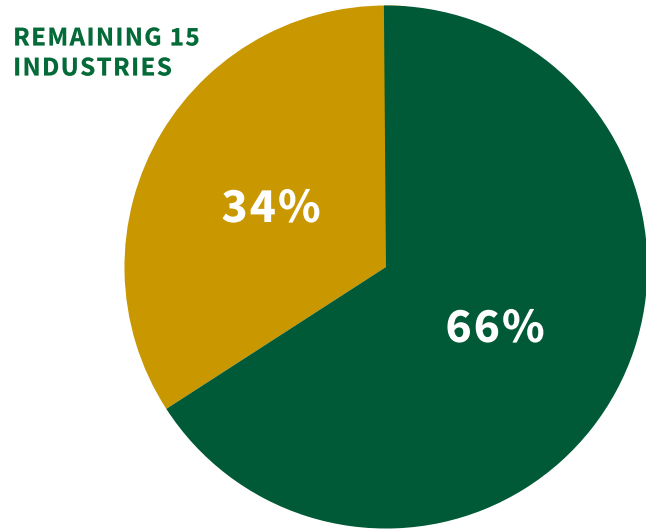

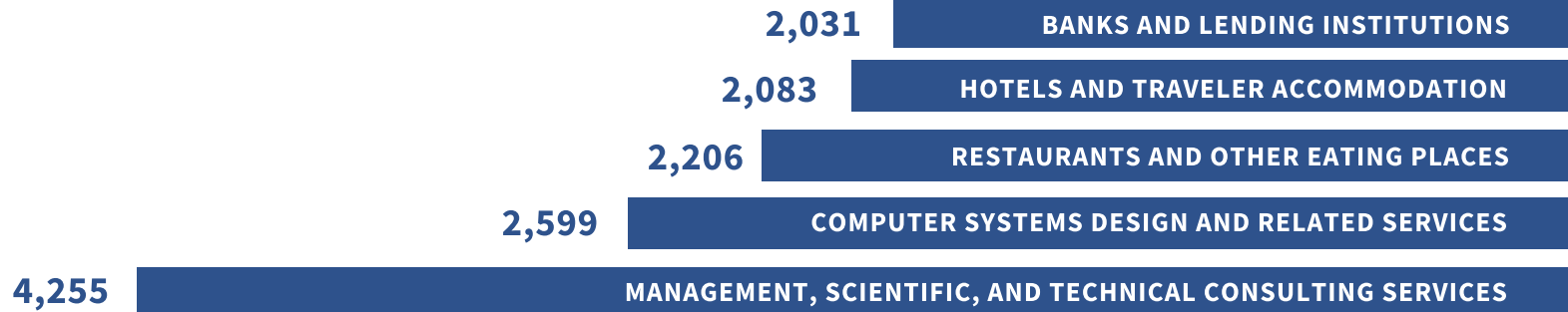

These are the top employers that advertised job openings between April and June 2017. Of the 88,513 total jobs advertised, the top ten employers advertised 10,454 positions and accounted for 11.8% of all jobs advertised in northern Virginia during this time period. 8 of the top 10 employers are in the Professional, Scientific, and Technical Services industry.

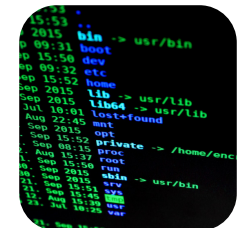
