

**Interested in Launching a Career in IT or Cybersecurity?
Attend Year Up's Marathon Info Session Week to get Started!**



What's **Year Up**? Year Up students take courses in information technology and/or cybersecurity and professional skills while at NOVA-Woodbridge; complete a six-month paid internship; obtain job placement assistance; and receive guidance and support from a professional staff coach and mentor. Participants earn a stipend of \$200-\$600 per month and 25-30 credits while surrounded by a supportive peer community. Within four months of completing the one-year program, 85% of graduates are employed full-time making a starting average salary of \$36,000+, or continuing their full-time education.

Who's eligible?

- 17-24 year-old prospective or current NOVA students
- Minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA in college courses
- Majoring in IT, Cybersecurity, General Studies or Information Systems Technology
